RANKL is essential for the formation, function and survival of decreasing the development of osteoclasts, which are cells that resorb (break down) bone. Denosumab binds to RANKL with high affinity and specificity, preventing the interaction between RANKL and RANK (receptor activator of nuclear factor-kappa B). This leads to a reduction in osteoclast numbers and function, and a decrease in bone resorption in cortical and trabecular bones, including cancer-induced bone destruction. The exact cause is unknown, although leading theories indicate both genetic and acquired factors (see Causes). Paget's disease may affect any one or several bones of the body (most commonly pelvis, tibia, femur, lumbar vertebrae, and skull), but never the entire skeleton, and does not spread from bone to bone. Rarely, a bone affected by Paget's disease can transform into a malignant bone cancer. 986e99ca89 Bisphosphonates were originally synthesized in the 19th century and used in industry for their antiscaling and anticorrosive properties. In the late 1960s their potential to treat diseases related to the metabolism of the bones became evident. The first generation of bisphosphonates included etidronic acid and clodronic acid which were introduced in the 1970s and 1980s. They were the first bisphosphonate drugs to be used successfully in the clinic. These interventions are focused on five domains including: physical symptoms, psychological symptoms, surveillance, health promotion and care coordination. Bisphosphonates such as zoledronic acid have been shown to delay skeletal complications such as fractures or Treatment for prostate cancer may involve active surveillance, surgery, radiation therapy - including brachytherapy (prostate brachytherapy) and external-beam radiation therapy, proton therapy, high-intensity focused ultrasound (HIFU), cryosurgery, hormonal therapy, chemotherapy, or some combination. However, a published review has found only high levels of evidence for interventions that target physical and psychological symptom management and health promotion, with no reviews of interventions for either care coordination or surveillance.
