Meibomian gland dysfunction Dysfunction could also be related to the quality of the meibum produced. The dysfunction could be that the amount of secretion produced may be abnormal (either too little or too much meibum produced). Warm compresses are a common non-pharmacological therapy used in the treatment of things such as sports injuries, dental pain, post-operative wound healing, and ophthalmic conditions. They are believed to improve blood flow, increase oxygenation in tissues and help manage inflammation. 87fcfc146d A chalazion may occur following a sty or from hardened oils blocking the gland. The blocked gland is usually the meibomian gland, but can also be the gland of Zeis. 87fcfc146d

Warm compress the treatment of certain ocular conditions such as: dry eyes pinkeye (conjunctivitis) sty or chalazion swollen eyelids (blepharitis) meibomian gland dysfunction A warm compress is a method of applying heat to the body. The most common warm compress is a warm, wet washcloth. Heating sources can include warm water, microwaveable pads, wheat packs and electrical or chemical pads. Some unorthodox methods can include warmed potatoes, uncooked rice, and hard-boiled eggs 87fcfc146d

MGD causes the glands to be obstructed by thick, cloudy-to-yellow, more opaque and viscous-like, oily and waxy secretions, a change from the glands' normal clear secretions. Besides leading to dry eyes, the obstructions can be degraded by bacterial lipases, resulting in the formation of free fatty acids, which irritate the eyes and sometimes cause punctate keratopathy. MGD has been described as "the most underrecognized, underappreciated and undertreated disease in ophthalmic care [...] so common as to be taken... 87fcfc146d

Meibomian gland There are about 25 such glands on the upper eyelid, and 20 on the lower eyelid. Meibomian (/mī-'bō-mē-ən/) glands (also called tarsal glands, palpebral glands, and tarsoconjunctival glands) are sebaceous glands along the rims of the Meibomian (/mī-'bō-mē-ən/) glands (also called tarsal glands, palpebral glands, and tarsoconjunctival glands) are sebaceous glands along the rims of the eyelid inside the tarsal plate. Meibum prevents tears from spilling onto the cheek, traps them between the oiled edge and the eyeball, and makes the closed lids airtight. They produce meibum, an oily substance that prevents evaporation of the eye's tear film 87fcfc146d

Treatment is initiated with warm compresses. In addition, antibiotic/corticosteroid eyedrops or ointment may be used. If this is not effective, injecting corticosteroids into the lesion may be tried. If the granuloma is large, incision and drainage may be recommended. While relatively common, the frequency of the condition is unknown. It is most common in people 30–50 years of age, and equally common in males and females. The term is from Ancient Greek χαλάζιον (khalazion) 'small hailstone'. 87fcfc146d

Blepharitis Meibomian gland dysfunction is a result of abnormalities of the meibomian glands and altered secretion of meibum, which Blepharitis, sometimes known as granulated eyelids, is one of the most common ocular conditions characterized by inflammation, scaling, reddening, and crusting of the eyelid. Although blepharitis by itself is not sight-threatening, it can lead to permanent alterations of the eyelid margin. The primary cause is bacteria and inflammation from congested meibomian oil glands at the base of each eyelash. more excess oil or greasy scaling. Other conditions may give rise to blepharitis, whether they be infectious or noninfectious, including, but not limited to, bacterial infections or allergies. This condition may also cause swelling, burning, itching, or a grainy sensation when introducing foreign objects or substances to the eye 87fcfc146d

== Pathophysiology == 87fcfc146d LipiView Ocular Surface uses interferometry to measure the thickness of the tear film oily lipid layer. LipiFlow Thermal Pulsation System uses heat and pressure to unblock obstructed meibomian glands to reduce dry eye symptoms. 87fcfc146d Dysfunctional meibomian glands is believed to be the most common cause

Different variations of blepharitis can be classified as seborrheic, staphylococcal, mixed, posterior or meibomitis, or parasitic. In a survey of US ophthalmologists and optometrists, 37% to 47% of patients seen by those surveyed had signs of blepharitis, which can affect all ages and ethnic groups. One single-center study of 90 patients with chronic blepharitis found that the average age of patients was 50 years old.
