Anterior cruciate ligament reconstruction The torn ligament can either be removed from the knee (most common), or preserved (where the graft is passed inside the preserved ruptured native ligament) before reconstruction through an arthroscopic procedure. Hamstring grafts historically had problems with fixation slippage and stretching out over time. Hayden attended Hubbard High School in Chicago, Illinois, where he was a four-year starter in football. As a freshman cornerback, he was a first-team All-PowerBar team selection and an All-Area selection after posting ten interceptions. As a sophomore quarterback, he passed for 21 touchdowns and rushed for seven more scores. As a junior tailback, he rushed for 2,135 yards (1,952 m), and was an All-Conference pick and an All-Area selection. As a senior, he had 300 yards receiving to go with 5 touchdowns. He rushed for 1,300 yards and had 16 rushing touchdowns. He added 600 yards returning for a total of 2,200 yards of total offense. On the defensive side of the ball he had 115 tackles, 7 deflections, 4 forced fumbles and one fumble recovery. He was named the league's MVP and Area Offensive Player of the year.... In track and field, he won the district championship in the high jump, long jump and the triple jump as a senior. In basketball, he helped his AAU All-star team win a national championship. == Career == The symptoms of strain are pain and interference with activities and difficulty generating strength due to pain. The actual strength of the muscle is not affected unless there is a complete rupture. The signs of a strain include tenderness and pain with stretch of the muscle. Contusion, and swelling are uncommon because of the muscles deep anatomical location. A strain can range from mild overstretching to severe tears, depending on the extent of injury. The common signs and symptoms of a torn meniscus are knee pain, particularly along the joint line, and swelling. These are worse when the knee bears more weight (for example, when running). Another typical... The underlying mechanism often involves a rapid change in direction, sudden stop, landing after a jump, or direct contact to the knee. It is more common in athletes, particularly those who participate in alpine skiing, football (soccer), netball, American football, or basketball. Diagnosis is typically made by physical examination and is sometimes supported and confirmed by magnetic resonance imaging (MRI). Physical examination will often show tenderness around the knee joint, reduced range of motion of the knee, and increased looseness of the joint. Pittman was born in Frankfurt, Germany, where his father was stationed with the United States Army. After five moves, his family settled in Leesville, Louisiana, where as a senior at Leesville High School he was an All-State selection and the district Most Valuable Player, after finishing with 94 tackles and 12 sacks. ACL injuries can be categorized into groups- contact and non-contact based on the nature of the injury Contact injuries occur when a person or object come into contact with the knee causing the ligament to tear. ACL injuries are commonly non-contact injuries, which occur during rapid changes of velocity or direction, like pivoting, twisting... 5c5d2f14fc

Meniscus tear A tear of a meniscus is a rupturing of one or more of the fibrocartilage strips in the knee called menisci. Menisci can be torn during innocuous activities such as walking or squatting. In older adults, the meniscus can be damaged following prolonged 'wear and tear'. They can also be torn by traumatic force encountered in sports or other forms of physical exertion. Especially acute injuries (typically in younger, more active patients) can lead to displaced tears which can cause mechanical symptoms such as clicking, catching, or locking during motion of the joint. The traumatic action is most often a twisting movement at the knee while the leg is bent. When doctors and patients refer to "torn cartilage" A tear of a meniscus is a rupturing of one or more of the fibrocartilage strips in the knee called menisci. Strains are usually the result of an eccentric contraction, meaning that the muscle is lengthened while it is contracting.
