It can be taken by mouth, applied as a cream, or injected. Other uses include the prevention of cytomegalovirus infections following transplant, and severe complications of Epstein-Barr virus infection. It is primarily used for the treatment of herpes simplex virus infections, chickenpox, and shingles e1e5afa182

In one of the largest outbreaks ever among high-school wrestlers at a four-week intensive training camp, HSV was identified in 60 of 175 wrestlers. Lesions were on the head in 73 percent of the wrestlers, the extremities in 42 percent, and the trunk in 28 percent. Physical symptoms sometimes recur in the skin. Previous adolescent HSV-1 seroconversion would preclude most herpes gladiatorum... e1e5afa182 Common side effects include nausea and diarrhea. Potentially serious side effects include kidney problems and low platelets. Greater care is recommended in those with poor liver or kidney function. It is generally considered safe for use in pregnancy with no harm having been observed. It appears to be safe during breastfeeding. Aciclovir is a nucleoside analogue that mimics guanosine. The first episode is often more severe and may be associated with fever, muscle pains, swollen lymph nodes and headaches.
