In the 19th and early 20th centuries, cats in London were commonly fed horse meat sold by itinerant traders known as Cats' Meat Men or Women, who traveled fixed routes to serve households. gut. Some countries also regulate which bacteria can be used: for example, in France, a product can only be labeled as yaourt or yoghourt if it has been fermented exclusively by Lactobacillus delbrueckii subsp. bulgaricus and Streptococcus thermophilus, a requirement that aligns with the international definition of yogurt in the Codex Alimentarius on fermented milk... 8538a4a38d Since 2002, feta has been a protected designation of origin (PDO) in the European Union. The first discovered probiotic was a certain strain of bacillus in Bulgarian yoghurt, called *Lactobacillus bulgaricus*. The discovery was made in 1905 by Bulgarian physician and microbiologist Stamen Grigorov. The modern-day theory is generally attributed to Russian Nobel Prize laureate Élie Metchnikoff, who postulated around 1907 that yoghurt-consuming Bulgarian peasants lived longer. 8538a4a38d

Helicobacter pylori eradication protocols pylori since eradication of this infection can induce remission in many patients when the tumor is limited to the stomach. Periodontal therapy or what is known as scaling and root planing and probiotics both need further studies to confirm their adjuvant role. This includes patients diagnosed with gastric adenocarcinoma (especially those with early-stage disease), patients found to have atrophic gastritis or intestinal metaplasia, as well as first-degree relatives of patients with gastric adenocarcinoma since the relatives themselves are at increased risk of gastric cancer partly due to the intrafamilial transmission. Appropriate therapy should be given for eradication. pylori. Patients with MALT lymphoma should also be tested and treated for H. pylori infection. Several consensus conferences, including the Maastricht Consensus Report, recommend testing and treating several other groups of patients but there is limited evidence of benefit. The primary goal of the treatment is not only temporary relief of symptoms but also total elimination of H. Patients with active duodenal or gastric ulcers and those with a prior ulcer history should be tested for H.
