Most humans mount significant immunoglobulin E responses only as a defense against parasitic infections. However, some individuals may respond to many common environmental antigens. It is a viscous colloidal gel containing water (90–95%), inorganic salts, antimicrobial enzymes (such as lysozymes), antibodies especially immunoglobulin A, and glycoproteins such as lactoferrin and mucins, which are produced by goblet cells in the mucous membranes and submucosal glands. They also kill many kinds of viruses, including the flu virus, the common cold virus, coronaviruses, and HIV. However, it is less effective against certain pathogens like norovirus and *Clostridioides difficile* and cannot physically remove harmful chemicals. Additionally, frequent use of hand sanitizer may disrupt the skin's microbiome and cause dermatitis. While hand washing with soap and water is generally preferred, hand sanitizer is a convenient alternative in settings where soap and water are unavailable. 90% alcohol rubs are more effective. Hand sanitizer (also known as hand antiseptic, hand disinfectant, hand rub, or handrub) is a liquid, gel, or foam used to kill viruses, bacteria, and other microorganisms on the hands 14c2e65366

Mucus for treating typical cases. Mucus forms a protective barrier between epithelial cells on the internal and external surfaces of the body and the outside environment. The mucosal barrier is nonetheless selectively permeable, allowing the diffusion of small particles and blocking the entrance of larger particles. Mucus helps to trap and remove inhaled particles, and prevent the entry of pathogenic fungi, bacteria and viruses at different sites. In the case of a viral infection such as cold or flu, the first stage and also the last stage of the infection cause the production of Mucus (, MEW-kəs) is a slippery gel produced by, and covering, mucous membranes.
