It is based on the application of software to enable continuous improvement through an Integrated System Model (ISM) of the business's physical assets, business processes, and machine learning. Lean also takes into account waste created through overburden ("Muri") and waste created through unevenness in work loads ("Mura"). Working from the perspective of the client who consumes a product or service, "value" is any action or process that a customer would be willing to pay for. 2889cc404f At its core, Lean eliminates activities that do not add value for the customer. Where just-in-time (JIT) manufacturing focuses on inventory strategy — receiving goods only as needed to reduce costs and waste — Lean goes further by reducing cycle time, flow time, and throughput time across the entire system, including marketing and customer service. According to one study: "While Just-In-Time manufacturing focuses on efficiency of inventory strategy to eliminate waste and enhance productivity, Lean manufacturing uses efficiency in its system setups to reduce cycle, flow, and throughput times being the added values to customers." 2889cc404f Lean construction required the application of a robust programmatic framework to all repair, renovation, maintenance, and or new build activities. While each project may be unique, the application of LEAN fundamental should be applied consistently. Lean construction is concerned with the alignment and holistic pursuit of concurrent and continuous improvements in all dimensions of the built and natural environment: design, construction, activation, maintenance, salvaging, and recycling. When Toyota started manufacturing cars, there was a difference in manufacturing conditions between Japan and the USA. Toyota had few educated

engineers and little prior experience. Car companies in the US employed a well-educated workforce in the cities and benefited from the research and student skill sets of established engineering schools. To tackle this shortfall in knowledge and experience, Toyota conducted an incremental approach to development that built on their existing knowledge and became the basis of the lean systems Toyota uses today. 2889cc404f

Design for lean manufacturing At the time of the study, the Japanese automakers were outperforming the American counterparts in speed, resources used in design, and design quality. The term Design for lean manufacturing is a process for applying lean concepts to the design phase of a system, such as a complex product or process. Conventional mass-production design focuses primarily on product functions and manufacturing costs; however, design for lean manufacturing systematically widens the design equation to include all factors that will determine a product's success across its entire value stream and life-cycle. Design. Design for lean manufacturing is a process for applying lean concepts to the design phase of a system, such as a complex product or process. The method has been used in architecture, healthcare, product development, processes design, information technology systems, and even to create lean business models. One goal is to reduce waste and maximize value, and other goals include improving the quality of the design and the reducing the time to achieve the final solution. The term describes methods of design in lean manufacturing companies as part of the study of Japanese industry by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
