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obstruction and carries Fetal distress, also known as non-reassuring fetal status, is a condition during pregnancy or labor in which the fetus shows signs of inadequate oxygenation. normally facilitates the transition to independent breathing. Meconium aspiration syndrome It describes the Meconium aspiration syndrome (MAS), also known as neonatal aspiration of meconium, is a medical condition affecting newborn infants. It describes the spectrum of disorders and pathophysiology of newborns born in meconium-stained amniotic fluid (MSAF) and have meconium within their lungs. substance which contains gastrointestinal secretions, amniotic fluid, bile acids, bile, blood, mucus, cholesterol, pancreatic secretions, lanugo, vernix caseosa and cellular debris. Meconium accumulates in the foetal gastrointestinal tract throughout the third trimester of pregnancy and it is the first intestinal discharge released within the first 48 hours after birth. emphysema is more frequent in premature infants who require mechanical ventilation for severe lung disease. (This supportive tissue is called the pulmonary interstitium. Infants with pulmonary interstitial emphysema are typically recommended for admission to a neonatal intensive care unit. Risk factors include previous maternal infection, preterm delivery (< 37 weeks gestation) and premature rupture of membranes (breakage of the amniotic sac) which substantially increases the risk of neonatal sepsis by allowing passage for bacteria to enter the womb prior to the birth of the infant. Preterm or low birth weight neonates are more vulnerable to neonatal infection. While preterm neonates are at a particularly high risk, all neonates can develop infection. Maternal screening for intrapartum infections reduce the risk of neonatal infection. Pregnant women... 20aaf778a2 Treatment primarily consists of intrauterine resuscitation, the goal of which is to restore oxygenation of the fetus. This can involve improving the

Transient tachypnea of the newborn Treatment is supportive and may include supplemental oxygen and antibiotics. Usually, this condition resolves over 24–72 hours. It is the most common cause of respiratory distress in term neonates. lungs to be inelastic and crumpled. It is caused by retained fetal lung fluid due to impaired clearance mechanisms. Meconium aspiration presents as a neonate with a prolonged delivery and meconium stained amniotic fluid, with decreased Transient tachypnea of the newborn is a respiratory problem that can be seen in the newborn shortly after delivery. It consists of a period of tachypnea (rapid breathing, higher than the normal range of 30–60 times per minute). The chest x-ray shows hyperinflation of

the lungs including prominent pulmonary vascular markings, flattening of the diaphragm, and fluid in the horizontal fissure of the right lung 20aaf778a2

administration can also be effective in meconium aspiration syndrome where it has been shown to help lower length of stay. 20aaf778a2 Risk factors for fetal distress/non-reassuring fetal status include anemia, restriction of fetal growth, maternal hypertension or cardiovascular disease, low amniotic fluid or meconium in the amniotic fluid, or a post-term pregnancy. The condition is detected most often with electronic fetal heart rate (FHR) monitoring through cardiotocography (CTG), which allows clinicians to measure changes in the fetal cardiac response to declining oxygen. Specifically, heart rate decelerations detected on CTG can represent danger to the fetus and to delivery. 20aaf778a2

Neonatal infection Signs and symptoms of infection may include respiratory distress, temperature instability, irritability, poor feeding, failure to thrive, persistent crying and skin rashes. Some neonatal infections such as HIV, hepatitis B, and malaria do not become apparent until much

later. Neonatal infections are infections of the neonate (newborn) acquired during prenatal development or within the first four weeks of life. Neonatal infections may be contracted by mother to child transmission, in the birth canal during childbirth, or after birth. Neonatal infections may present soon after delivery, or take several weeks to show symptoms

amniotic fluid (MSAF). 20aaf778a2 Some childhood diseases include: 20aaf778a2 It was introduced in the 1960s as a means of terminating pregnancy and inducing labor in intrauterine death, but is currently used as a treatment in order to correct fetal heart rate changes caused by umbilical cord compression, indicated by variable decelerations seen on fetal heart rate monitoring. In severe cases of oligohydramnios, amnioinfusion may be performed prophylactically to prevent umbilical cord compression. 20aaf778a2

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
