The block was launched on July 1, 1985, and it replaced A&E on Nickelodeon's channel space after it spun off into its own 24-hour channel. Nerd Nite Nerd Nite has been held at more than 100 cities worldwide, including Harare, San Francisco, Wellington, Monrovia, Orlando, Toronto and Madison, Wisconsin. It was started in 2003 by then-graduate student (now East Carolina University professor) Chris Balakrishan at the Midway Cafe in the Jamaica Plain neighborhood of Boston. It has also held "global festivals" and a 2014 event was co-hosted with Smithsonian magazine. It launched a short-lived Nerd Nite: The Magazine in January 2012 and has also featured an occasional podcast.
