Although structures called vestigial often appear functionless, they may retain lesser functions or develop minor new ones. Many human characteristics are also vestigial in other primates and related animals. Vestigial organs are sometimes called rudimentary organs. The physiological type occurs before 28 weeks after conception and tend to last five to ten minutes. intrauterine hiccups are of two types.
