American musician, singer, and songwriter who co-founded the Beach Boys. He later contributed original material to their catalog, including "Forever" (1970), his best-known song. The only dedicated surfer in the group, his lifestyle embodied the "California myth" that inspired and was celebrated in many of the band's early songs. Dennis also offered Poops and Hubba Hubba as the album's working titles. The album's title and cover artwork (a painting based on the early 20th-century sculpture "End of the Trail") are a tongue-in-cheek, self-aware nod to the band's early surfing image.
