As of 2023, the medications liraglutide, naltrexone/bupropion, orlistat, semaglutide, tirzepatide and phentermine/topiramate are approved by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for weight management in combination with reduced-calorie diet and increased physical activity. Tirzepatide The most common Tirzepatide is a gastric inhibitory polypeptide (GIP) analog and a GLP-1 receptor agonist. It is used as an antidiabetic medication to treat type 2 diabetes (T2D) and for weight loss. Tirzepatide is administered via subcutaneous injections (under the skin). In the United States, it is sold under the brand name Zepbound for weight loss and for the treatment of obstructive sleep apnea. These episodes are termed "apneas" with complete or near-complete cessation of breathing, or "hypopneas" when the reduction in breathing is partial. This type of sleep apnea is characterized by recurrent episodes of complete or partial obstruction of the upper airway leading to reduced or absent breathing during sleep. A high frequency of apneas or hypopneas during sleep may interfere with the quality of sleep, which – in combination with disturbances in blood oxygenation – is thought to contribute to negative consequences to health and quality of life. The terms obstructive sleep apnea syndrome (OSAS) or obstructive sleep apnea-hypopnea syndrome (OSAHS) may be used to refer to OSA when it is associated with symptoms during the daytime (e.

The most effective treatment for obesity is bariatric surgery. Surgery for severe obesity is associated with long-term weight loss and decreased overall mortality. One study found a weight loss of between 14% and 25% (depending on the type of procedure performed) at 10 years, and a 29% reduction in all cause mortality when compared to standard weight loss measures. Another study also found reduced mortality in those who underwent bariatric surgery for severe obesity. b39ac6b353

Anti-obesity medication receptor agonists such as semaglutide (Ozempic, Wegovy) or tirzepatide (Zepbound) became popular for weight loss because they are more effective than earlier Anti-obesity medication or weight loss medications are pharmacological agents that reduce excess body fat and cause weight loss. These medications alter one of the fundamental processes of weight regulation, by: reducing appetite and consequently energy intake, increasing energy expenditure, redirecting nutrients from adipose to lean tissue, or interfering with the absorption of calories b39ac6b353

Diabetes medication Most GLP-1 receptor agonists (liraglutide, exenatide, tirzepatide, pramlintide and others) are administered by injection. It is marketed under the brand name Mounjaro for type II diabetes, and Zepbound for Drugs used in diabetes treat types of diabetes mellitus by decreasing glucose levels in the blood. Other anti-diabetes medications (including semaglutide as Rybelsus) are administered orally and are thus called oral hypoglycemic agents or oral antihyperglycemic agents. (Semaglutide is available both as a pill and as an injection.) There are different classes of hypoglycemic drugs, and selection of the appropriate agent depends on the nature of the diabetes (Type I vs Type II), the age and situation of the person, as well as other patient factors. == Pharmacology == b39ac6b353 Type 1 diabetes is an endocrine disorder characterized by hyperglycemia due to autoimmune destruction of insulin-secreting

pancreatic beta cells. Insulin is a hormone needed by cells to take in glucose from the blood. Insufficient levels of insulin due to Type 1 diabetes can lead to chronic hyperglycemia and eventual multiorgan damage, resulting in renal, neurologic, cardiovascular, and other serious complications. The treatment for Type 1 diabetes involves regular insulin injections.

Obesity is defined as a person having excess body fat. Obesity can be measured in different ways, but most common is the Body Mass Index (BMI) which is calculated based on a person's height and weight.

Definition of obesity == Weight loss drugs have been developed since the early twentieth century, and many have been banned or withdrawn from the market due to adverse effects, including deaths; other drugs proved ineffective. Although many earlier drugs were stimulants such as amphetamines, in the early 2020s, GLP-1 receptor agonists became popular for weight loss.

Treatment for obesity often consists of weight loss via healthy nutrition and increasing physical exercise.

GLP-1 receptor agonist Incretin mimetics are substances that mimic the actions of incretin hormones such as GLP-1 and GIP. (Zepbound), and liraglutide (Saxenda). GLP-1 analogs are molecules that are structurally almost identical to the endogenous GLP-1 hormone. Studies reported that on average people regain more than half (50-70%) of the lost weight within a year after stopping Glucagon-like peptide-1 (GLP-1) receptor agonists, also known as GLP-1 agonists, GLP-1RAs, and informally as simply GLP-1s, are a class of medications that activate the GLP-1 receptor, causing reduced blood sugar, reduced appetite, and reduced energy intake b39ac6b353

Anorectic Ghrelin, leptin, and peptide YY are among the hormones involved in appetite control. The understanding of anorexiatic effects is crucial in the development of interventions for weight management, eating disorders, and related health concerns. Additionally, neurotransmitters such as serotonin and dopamine in the central nervous system contribute significantly to the regulation of food intake. The anorexiatic effect can be induced through diverse mechanisms,

ranging from hormonal regulation to neural signaling. These substances work by affecting the central nervous system or certain neurotransmitters to create a feeling of fullness or reduce the desire to eat b39ac6b353
