Seborrhoeic dermatitis Symptoms include flaky, scaly, greasy, and occasionally itchy and inflamed skin. Mild seborrhoeic dermatitis of the scalp may be described in lay terms as dandruff due to the dry, flaky character of the skin. Regular use of an over-the-counter or prescription antifungal shampoo or cream is a common treatment. As dandruff may refer to any dryness or scaling of

the scalp, not all dandruff is seborrhoeic dermatitis. with an agreeable side effect profile. Seborrhoeic dermatitis is sometimes inaccurately referred to as seborrhoea. Areas of the skin rich in oil-producing glands are often affected including the scalp, face, and chest. The topical Seborrhoeic dermatitis or seborrheic dermatitis (depending upon the variety of English used) is a long-term skin disorder. One single-center study of 90 patients with chronic blepharitis found that the average age of patients was 50 years old. Blepharitis Although blepharitis by itself is not sight-threatening, it can lead to permanent alterations of the eyelid margin. This condition

may also cause swelling, burning, itching, or a grainy sensation when introducing foreign objects or substances to the eye. Eye drops or ointments containing corticosteroids are frequently used in conjunction with blepharitis, sometimes known as granulated eyelids, is one of the most common ocular conditions characterized by inflammation, scaling, reddening, and crusting of the eyelid. The primary cause is bacteria and inflammation from congested meibomian oil glands at the base of each eyelash. Other conditions may give rise to blepharitis, whether they be infectious or noninfectious, including, but not limited to, bacterial infections or allergies. The anti-mite drug ivermectin can be an effective treatment for reducing symptoms.

Skin care differs from dermatology by its inclusion of non-physician professionals, such as estheticians and nursing staff. Skin care includes modifications of individual behavior and of environmental and working conditions. Ketoconazole Ketoconazole shampoo in conjunction Ketoconazole, sold under the brand name Nizoral, among others, is an antiandrogen, antifungal, and antiglucocorticoid medication used to treat a number of fungal infections. Other uses include treatment of excessive male-patterned hair growth in women and Cushing's syndrome. Applied to the skin it is used for fungal skin infections such as tinea, cutaneous candidiasis, pityriasis versicolor, dandruff, and seborrheic dermatitis. Taken by mouth it is a less preferred option and recommended for only severe infections when other agents cannot be used. Ketoconazole is used orally in dosages of 200 to 400 mg per day in the
