No Sanskrit original has been found, and the title of the sutra has been back-translated into Sanskrit by scholars as either Amitāyur-dhyāna Sūtra or Amitāyur-buddhānusmṛti-sūtra ("Amitāyus Buddha-mindfulness Sūtra"). The Amitāyus Sutra contains the past-life tale of Dharmākara Bodhisattva, who would go on to become Buddha Amitābha. It also explains how he gave rise to the Original Vows which led to the creation of the

Pure Land of Sukhavati. The title of the sutra is often translated in English as either the Sutra [on the Buddha] of Immeasurable Life, or simply the Immeasurable Life Sutra. The Immeasurable Life Sutra is one of the three central scriptures of East Asian Pure Land Buddhism, and is widely revered and chanted by Pure Land Buddhists throughout Asia. c7c3f4abbb

Pure lands are said to be places without the sufferings of samsara and to be beyond the three planes of existence. The Amitābha Sūtra was translated from an Indic language into Classical Chinese by Tripiṭaka master Kumārajīva in 402. The original Sukhāvatīvyūha sutras may have existed in India as early as the first or second centuries CE (during the Kushan era). They may have been composed in Gandhari or some other Prakrit language. Once there, one can meet a Buddha face to face and study under them without any of the distractions or fears of our world. Since it is much easier to attain enlightenment in a pure land, many Mahayana Buddhists strive to be reborn in one. The most popular one today is Sukhavati ("Land of Bliss"), the pure land of Buddha Amitābha, though some Buddhists may also aspire to be reborn in other pure lands (such as Maitreya's and Medicine Guru's). == History == c7c3f4abbb Beginning on the 25th of Kislev on the Hebrew calendar, Hanukkah lasts for eight nights and days. Each night is marked by lighting a Hanukkah menorah, a nine-branched candelabrum containing spaces for eight ceremonial lights plus one additional candle, the shámash (שָׁמַשׁ, 'attendant'), which is used to light the others. Aside from the shamash, one candle is lit on the first night, two on the second, and so on, until all eight are burning together on the final night. It is the only Jewish holiday that starts in one month of the Hebrew calendar (Kislev) and concludes in another (Tevet). c7c3f4abbb The term "Pure Land" is common in East Asian Buddhist sources (Chinese: 淨土; pinyin: Jìngtǔ). Sanskrit Buddhist sources contain the equivalent concept under terms such as buddha-field (buddhakṣetra) or more technically a pure buddha-field (Sanskrit: viśuddha-buddhakṣetra, pariśuddha-kṣetra, kṣetraṃ viśuddham, etc). It is also known by the Sanskrit term buddhabhūmi (buddha-land). In Tibetan Buddhism meanwhile, the term "pure realms" (Tibetan: རང་པོའི་ལོང་ཁོང་པོ་ Wylie: dag pa'i zhing) is also used as a synonym for buddhakṣetra. c7c3f4abbb

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
