

# How Long Do You Boil Eggs Hard Boiled

Eggs can easily cause damage when thrown at property, and egging is considered vandalism. When thrown at cars, eggs can dent a body panel or scratch off paint where the shell breaks. Egg whites can damage certain types of vehicle and building paint. Dried egg can be difficult to remove, and removal attempts with scrapers, abrasives or flammable cleaning solvents can damage some surfaces. Description == Eggs have a long history of use as food, following the history of the domestic chicken, and recipes that include boiled eggs are found in the first known cookbook, *De re coquinaria*, in which at least one recipe calls for the use of preserved boiled eggs. Alexander Pope recommended a method of cooking eggs over the embers or ashes of an open fire. Rules vary by location.
