More generally, an angle subtended by an arc of a curve is the angle subtended by the corresponding chord of the arc. b8120aad34 For example, a circular arc subtends the central angle formed by the two radii through the arc endpoints. b8120aad34 One standard definition is that an angle is a figure consisting of two rays which lie in a plane and share a common endpoint. Alternatively, given such a figure, an angle might be defined as: the opening between the rays; the area of the plane that lies between the rays... b8120aad34 The above definition of a subtended plane angle remains valid in three-dimensional space (3D), as one vertex and two endpoints (assumed non-collinear) define an Euclidean plane in 3D. b8120aad34

However, some special angles can be trisected: for example, it is trivial to trisect a right angle or an angle of 135 degrees, Angle trisection is the construction of an angle equal to one third of a given arbitrary angle, using only two tools: an unmarked straightedge and a compass b8120aad34

It is possible to trisect an arbitrary angle by using tools other than straightedge and compass. For example, neusis construction, also known to ancient Greeks, involves simultaneous sliding and rotation of a marked straightedge, which cannot be achieved with the original tools. Other techniques were developed by mathematicians over the centuries. b8120aad34 They can also represent the orientation of a mobile frame of reference in physics or the orientation of a general basis in three dimensional linear algebra. b8120aad34
