Aranjanam During the ceremony, charadu (thread), one in black or red cotton and the other a chain in gold are Aranjanam or Araiyan Kodi or Molathadu (Malayalam: അറാഞ്ചനം Tamil:அராஜன் கோடி) is a thin waist ornament often worn by infants and children in southern Asia, particularly in southern India, although many adults also choose to wear it. In the state of Tamil Nadu, it is known as 'Araiyan Kodi' and in Kerala it is called 'Aranjana Charadu'. It is believed that wearing aranjanam protects against bad spirits and brings good luck. The day, also called Shravana Purnima ("Full Moon of Shravana") in other parts of India, usually occurs the day after the Shravana nakshatra, which marks Kerala's Onam festival. On the following day, usually coinciding with the Raksha Bandhan festival in North and Central India, the Gayatri Mantra is recited 1,008 times.
