Cervical ripening has primarily been performed in the inpatient setting. Due to a variety of reasons, such as cost and patient preference, the capacity to undergo outpatient cervical ripening is being explored. Cervical ripening options require ample time to... Most research suggests that, during pregnancy, sexual desire and frequency of sexual relations decrease. Hysterosalpingography Hysterosalpingography has vital role in treatment of infertility, especially in the case of fallopian tube blockage. A normal result shows the filling of the uterine cavity and the bilateral filling of the fallopian tube with the injection material. HSG is contraindicated during menstruation, suspected cancer, pregnancy, unprotected Hysterosalpingography (HSG), also known as uterosalpingography, is a radiologic procedure to investigate the shape of the uterine cavity and the shape and patency of the fallopian tubes. In this procedure, a radio-opaque material is injected into the cervical canal, and radiographs are taken. mucus plugs, debris, or opening of mild adhesions in the

fallopian tubes. It is a special x-ray procedure using dye to look at the womb (uterus) and fallopian tubes. To demonstrate tubal patency, spillage of the material into the peritoneal cavity needs to be observed c39e83a8b2

In relation to the vagina, the part of the cervix that opens into the uterus is called the internal os while the opening of the cervix into the vagina is called the external os. Between those extremes is the conduit commonly called the cervical canal. The lower part of the cervix, known as the vaginal portion of the cervix (or ectocervix), bulges into the top of the vagina. The endocervix borders... c39e83a8b2 During pregnancy, the mucus has viscoelastic properties and can be described as cloudy, clear, thick, salty and sticky. It holds innate and adaptive immunity properties allowing for protection of the cervical epithelium during pregnancy. Toward the end of the pregnancy, when the cervix thins, some blood is released into the cervix which causes the mucus to become bloody. Risk factors include infection of the amniotic fluid, prior PROM, bleeding in the later parts of pregnancy, smoking, and a mother who is underweight. Diagnosis is suspected based on symptoms and speculum exam and may be supported by testing the vaginal fluid or by ultrasound. If it occurs before 37 weeks it is known as PPRM (preterm prelabor rupture of membranes) otherwise it is known as term PROM. c39e83a8b2

Bloody show is recognized through the presence of mucus and blood that is combined and discharged from the cervix before labor occurs. Bloody show is sometimes used as an indication of active labor, and can occur as a result of the onset of labor. Bloody show can also occur with other symptoms of onset of labor, including painful contractions, degree of cervical effacement, and/or spontaneous membrane rupture. Severity of symptoms differs from person to person, and usually those symptoms are more commonly found than bloody show. c39e83a8b2 Bloody show...

c39e83a8b2 Treatment is based on how far along a woman is in pregnancy and whether complications are present. In those at or near term without any complications, induction of labor is generally recommended. Time may also be provided for labor to begin spontaneously. Rupture of membranes A premature rupture of membranes (PROM) is a rupture of the amnion that occurs at full term and prior to the onset of labor. Normally, it occurs spontaneously at full term either during or at the beginning of labor. In cases of PROM, options include expectant management without intervention, or interventions such as oxytocin or other methods of labor induction, and both are usually accompanied by close monitoring of maternal and fetal health. In the United States, more than 120,000 pregnancies per year are affected by a premature rupture of membranes, which is the cause of about one third of preterm deliveries. Preterm premature rupture of membranes (PPROM) is when water breaks both before the onset of labor and before the pregnancy's 37 week gestation. Rupture of the membranes is known colloquially as "breaking (one's) water," especially when induced rather than spontaneous, or as one's "water breaking". Cervical effacement This process occurs during labor to prepare the cervix for dilation to allow the fetus to pass through the vagina. Cervical ripening is contraindicated in pregnancies presenting with the following conditions: Cervical effacement or cervical ripening refers to the thinning and shortening of the cervix. While this is a normal, physiological process that occurs at the later end of pregnancy, it can also be induced through medications and procedures. on the stiffness of the cervix in considering induction of labor c39e83a8b2

During gestation, the cervix maintains pregnancy by increasing synthesis of various proteins. These proteins have defined interactions that allow the formation of matrix proteins to help fortify the uterine cervix. Toward the end of pregnancy, a series of hormone-mediated biochemical process takes place to degrade the collagen and fiber network to cause the cervix to ripen during labor. Failure to ripen the cervix during labor may delay its onset and cause complications. Current efforts to induce labor include pharmacologic, non-pharmacologic, mechanical and surgical methods. c39e83a8b2 In the later stages of pregnancy, the cervix may already have opened up to 1–3 cm (or more in rarer circumstances), but during labor, repeated uterine contractions lead to further widening of the cervix to about 6 centimeters. From that point, pressure from the presenting part (head in vertex births or bottom in breech births), along with uterine contractions, will dilate the cervix to 10 centimeters, which is "complete." Cervical dilation is accompanied by effacement, the thinning of the cervix. c39e83a8b2 Sex during pregnancy is a low-risk behavior except when the healthcare provider advises that sexual intercourse be avoided for particular medical reasons. For

a healthy pregnant woman, there are a variety of safe ways to have sex during pregnancy. c39e83a8b2 HSG is considered a diagnostic procedure. It is used in the workup of infertile females to assess the patency of fallopian tubes, assess the competency of the cervix or congenital abnormality of the uterus in multiple miscarriages, assess the patency of fallopian tubes after surgery or tubal ligation, or before reversal of tubal ligation. Bloody show vagina near the end of pregnancy. It is caused by thinning and dilation of the cervix, leading to detachment of the cervical mucus plug that seals the cervix Bloody show or show is the passage of a small amount of blood or blood-tinged mucus through the vagina near the end of pregnancy. The bloody show may be expelled from the vagina in pieces or altogether and often appears as a jelly-like piece of mucus stained with blood. Although the bloody show may be alarming at first, it is not a concern for patient health after 37 weeks of gestation. It is caused by thinning and dilation of the cervix, leading to detachment of the cervical mucus plug that seals the cervix during pregnancy and tearing of small cervical blood vessels, and is one of the signs that labor may be imminent c39e83a8b2

It involves three stages of labour: the shortening and opening of the cervix during the first stage, descent and birth of the baby during the second, and the birth of the placenta during the third. During the first stage, contractions gradually become stronger and closer together. The postpartum period is the time of recovery for the mother and infant, in which both newborn and mother are monitored. All major health organisations advise that immediately after

giving birth, regardless of the mode of birth, that the infant be placed on the mother's chest (termed skin-to-skin contact), and to delay any other routine procedures for at least one to two hours or until the baby has had its first breastfeeding. c39e83a8b2 == In childbirth == c39e83a8b2 The cervical mucus plug (CMP) acts as a protective barrier by deterring the passage of bacteria into the uterus, and contains a variety of antimicrobial agents, including immunoglobulins, and similar antimicrobial peptides to those found in nasal mucus. The CMP inhibits the migration of vaginal bacteria towards the uterus, protecting against opportunistic infections that can lead to pelvic inflammatory disease and the onset of preterm labor. Ensuring the presence and proper function of the CMP is essential in reducing severe infections and promoting overall reproductive health. c39e83a8b2
