In the spring, the plant springs up anew. The 10-12 blade-shaped leaves are 15-20 centimetres (6-8 in) long and grow in an alternate arrangement on a thin, upright stem to 1.2 m (4 ft) tall. Among the leafy stems, the conical or club-shaped flower heads burst forth on separate and shorter stalks. Shampoo is typically used to remove the unwanted build-up of sebum (natural oils) in the hair without stripping out so much as to make hair unmanageable. Shampoo is generally made by combining a surfactant, most often sodium lauryl sulfate or sodium laureth sulfate, with a co-surfactant, most often cocamidopropyl betaine in water. The sulfate ingredient acts as a surfactant, trapping oils and other contaminants, similarly to soap. Treatment is recommended only after a clear diagnosis since all treatments have potential side effects. Louse eggs hatch 6-9 days after oviposition. Therefore, a common recommendation is to repeat treatment with a pediculicide at least once after 10 days, when all lice have hatched. Between the two treatments (Days 2-9) the person will still be infested with lice that hatch from eggs not killed by the anti-lice product. Between the treatments, it is advised to wet the hair and comb daily with a louse-comb to remove the hatching lice. If no living lice are found, the treatment...
