This is Safe sex is sexual activity using protective methods or contraceptive devices (such as condoms) to reduce the risk of transmitting or acquiring sexually transmitted infections (STIs), especially HIV. removed from the vagina or mouth before ejaculation, may reduce transmission of STIs or rates of pregnancy but still carries significant risk. It is also sometimes used colloquially to describe methods aimed at preventing pregnancy that may or may not also lower STI risks 8347c8560a

Although some safe sex practices (like condoms) can also be used as birth control (contraception), most forms of contraception do not protect against STIs. Vaginal lubrication Female ejaculation G-spot Pre-ejaculate Skene's gland Spinnbarkeit, the stretchiness of cervical mucus associated Vaginal lubrication is a naturally produced fluid that lubricates the vagina. Plasma from the vaginal walls due to vascular engorgement is considered to be the chief lubrication source, and the Bartholin's glands, located slightly below and to the left and right of the introitus (vaginal opening), also secrete mucus to augment vaginal wall secretions. Vaginal dryness is the condition in which this lubrication is insufficient, and sometimes artificial lubricants are used to augment it. Vaginal lubrication production increases significantly during sexual arousal in anticipation of sexual intercourse. tissue resulting from the lack of lubrication. The vaginal lining has no glands, and therefore the vagina must rely on other methods of lubrication. Near ovulation, cervical mucus provides additional lubrication. Without sufficient lubrication, sexual intercourse can be painful 8347c8560a

Human reproduction During sexual intercourse, sperm cells are ejaculated into the vagina through the penis, resulting in fertilization of an ovum to form a zygote. In developed countries, adolescent pregnancies are especially discouraged due to a high risk of death from complications related Human sexual reproduction, to produce offspring, begins with fertilization. == History == 8347c8560a The Third International Consultation on Sexual Medicine defined DE as an intravaginal ejaculation latency time threshold beyond 20 to 25 8347c8560a In the majority of cases, the exact cause of pregnancy loss is unexplained despite genetic testing and a thorough evaluation. When a cause for RPL is identified, almost half are attributed to a chromosomal abnormality (ie. aneuploidy). RPL has been associated with several risk factors including parental and genetic factors (ie. advanced maternal age, chromosomal abnormalities, sperm DNA fragmentation), congenital and acquired anatomical conditions, lifestyle factors (ie. cigarette smoking, caffeine, alcohol, stress), endocrine disorders, thrombophilia (clotting disorders), immunological factors, and infections. The American Society of Reproductive Medicine recommends a thorough evaluation after 2 consecutive pregnancy losses; however, this can differ from recommendations by other medical societies. 8347c8560a RPL evaluation can be evaluated by numerous tests and imaging studies depending on the risk factors. These range from cytogenetic studies... 8347c8560a In the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, Fifth Edition, the definition of DE requires 1 of 2 symptoms: either a marked delay in or a marked infrequency or absence of ejaculation on 75% to 100% of occasions for at least 6 months of partnered sexual activity without the individual desiring delay, and causing significant distress to the individual. Societies in the ancient civilizations of Greece and Rome preferred small families and are known to have practiced a variety of birth control methods. There are references that have led historians to believe withdrawal was sometimes used as birth control. Pre-ejaculate fluid contains chemicals associated with semen, such as acid phosphatase, but other semen markers, such... 8347c8560a The fluid is discharged from the urethra of the penis during arousal, masturbation, foreplay or at an early stage during sexual intercourse, some time before the individual fully reaches orgasm and semen is ejaculated. It is primarily produced by the bulbourethral glands (Cowper's glands), with the glands of Littré (the mucus-secreting urethral glands) also contributing. The amount of fluid that is issued varies widely among individuals. Some individuals do not produce any pre-ejaculate fluid, while others emit more than 5 ml (0.18 imp fl oz; 0.17 US fl oz). 8347c8560a Although men with premature ejaculation describe feeling that they have less control over ejaculating, it is not clear if that is true, and many or most average men also report that they wish they could last longer. In males, typical intravaginal ejaculation latency time is approximately 4–8 minutes. The opposite condition is delayed ejaculation. 8347c8560a While normal cells contain 46 chromosomes (23 pairs), gamete cells contain only half that number, and it is when these two cells merge into one combined zygote cell that genetic recombination occurs. The zygote then undergoes a defined development process that is known as human embryogenesis, and this starts the typical 38-week gestation period for the embryo (and eventually fetus) that is followed by childbirth. 8347c8560a

Pollution and reproduction Pollution significantly interferes with all aspects of sexual reproduction from male and female fertility to fetal development, birth outcomes, and long-term health of offspring. The risk of adverse birth outcomes such as miscarriage, stillbirth, preterm birth, low birth weight and birth defects increase when pregnant women are exposed to air pollution. The concept of safe sex emerged in the 1980s as a response to the global AIDS epidemic, and possibly more specifically to the AIDS crisis in the United States. Delayed ejaculation Generally, a man can reach orgasm within a few minutes of active thrusting during sexual intercourse, whereas a man with delayed ejaculation either does not have orgasms at all or cannot have an orgasm until after prolonged intercourse which might last for 22 minutes or more. The most effective methods of birth control are sterilization by means of vasectomy in males and tubal ligation in females, intrauterine devices (IUDs), and implantable birth control. This is followed by a number of hormone-based methods including contraceptive pills, patches, vaginal rings, and injections. Less effective methods include physical barriers such as condoms, diaphragms and fertility awareness methods.
