The **Toddlers' Truce** policy may have originated when the BBC resumed television The **Toddlers' Truce** was an early British television scheduling policy that required transmissions to terminate for an hour each weekday between 6. 00pm – after the end of children's broadcasting and the start of the evening programmes – so that young children could be put to bed.
