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Color is a feminist anthology edited by Cherrie Moraga and Gloria E. The book centers on the experiences of women of color and emphasizes the points of what is now called intersectionality within their multiple identities, challenging white feminists who made claims to solidarity based on sisterhood. Anzaldúa first published *This Bridge Called My Back: Writings by Radical Women of Color* is a feminist anthology edited by Cherrie Moraga and Gloria E. Writings in the anthology, along with works by other prominent feminists of color, call for a greater prominence within feminism for race-related subjectivities, and ultimately laid the foundation for third wave feminism.
