There may be signs of septic shock. A physical examination reveals abdominal tenderness and possible loss of bowel sounds. An abdominal radiography shows colonic dilation. White blood cell count is usually elevated. Severe sepsis may present with hypothermia or leukopenia. 34a7127098

Toxic megacolon Toxic megacolon is an acute form of colonic distension. It is characterized by a very dilated colon (megacolon), accompanied by abdominal distention, bloating, fever, abdominal pain, and/or shock. The risk of death increases significantly if the colon ruptures, with mortality reported at 40% or higher. better when surgery is performed early on 34a7127098

It typically starts as a benign tumor, often in the form of a polyp, which over time becomes cancerous. Signs and symptoms may include blood in the stool, a change in bowel movements, weight loss, abdominal pain, and fatigue. Risk factors include diet, obesity, smoking, and lack of physical activity. Some of the inherited genetic disorders that can cause colorectal cancer include familial adenomatous polyposis and hereditary non-polyposis colon cancer; however, these represent less than 5% of cases. Other causes of spontaneous perforation include caustic ingestion, pill esophagitis, Barrett's esophagus, infectious ulcers in patients with AIDS, and

Rupture Hemoperitoneum (also haemoperitoneum, sometimes also hematoperitoneum) is the presence of blood in the peritoneal cavity. Hemoperitoneum is generally classified as a surgical emergency; in most cases, urgent laparotomy is needed to identify and control the source of the bleeding. Therefore, large-scale or rapid blood loss into the abdomen will reliably induce hemorrhagic shock and, if untreated, may rapidly lead to death. Bleeding due to a ruptured ectopic pregnancy or uterine rupture. The abdominal cavity is highly distensible and may easily hold greater than five liters of blood, or more than the entire circulating blood volume for an average-sized individual. The blood accumulates in the space between the inner lining of the abdominal wall and the internal abdominal organs 34a7127098

Toxic megacolon is usually a complication of inflammatory bowel disease, such as ulcerative colitis and, more rarely, Crohn's disease, and of some infections of the colon, including *Clostridioides difficile* infections, which have led to pseudomembranous colitis. Other forms of megacolon exist and can be congenital (present since birth, such as Hirschsprung's disease). It can also be caused by *Entamoeba histolytica* and *Shigella*. with intravenous fluids and antibiotics. Occasionally the hole can be sewn closed while other times a bowel resection is required. Even with maximum treatment the risk of death can be as high as 50%. A hole from a stomach ulcer occurs in about 1 per 10,000 people per year, while one from diverticulitis occurs in about 0.4 per 10,000 people per year. 34a7127098

Among domesticated horses, colic is the leading cause of premature death. Clinical signs of colic generally require veterinary evaluation and treatment. flat sides, a clue to the surgeon to look for more stones. The term colic can encompass all forms of gastrointestinal conditions which cause pain as well as other causes of abdominal pain not involving the gastrointestinal tract. Colic surgery is usually an expensive procedure as it is major abdominal surgery, often with intensive aftercare. There are a variety of different causes of colic, some of which can prove fatal without surgical intervention.

Recognizing and understanding these signs is pivotal, as timely action can spell the difference between a brief moment of discomfort and a life-threatening situation. The main risk of surgery is rupture of the colon (15% of cases), and 92% of horses that are recovered Colic in horses is defined as abdominal pain, but it is a clinical symptom rather than a diagnosis. The incidence of colic in the general horse population has been estimated between 4 and 10 percent over the course of the average lifespan.
