

Barrio De La Magdalena

The Tequistlatec language, now extinct, used to be spoken in Tequisistlán. The first of the barrios were named in 2011 by city Secretary of Tourism Alejandro Rojas Díaz Durán. Each of the twenty-one named neighborhoods received stylistic scrolls with the accreditation with acceptance by registration in the city's official gazette, Gaceta Oficial del DF. The first to receive its scroll was Santa María Magdalena Atlitic. The club's home ground is the Estadio Sierra Nevada, since 2018. Unión Magdalena was founded as Deportivo Samarios on 10 March 1951. The team was founded with the help of José Eduardo Gnecco Correa and Eduardo Dávila Riascos. It was formed by the Hungaria FbC Roma squad when it was disbanded after a tour in South America. The first team consisted of 10 Colombians, 8 Hungarians, 2 Yugoslavs, 1 Austrian, 1 Argentine, 1 Italian and 1 Romanian. Deportivo Samarios debuted in the league that same year and placed 14th. Magdalena Contreras In an effort to preserve the area's forests and natural resources, the borough government has started promoting ecotourism. As of the 2010 census, it has a population of 239,086 inhabitants and is the third-least populous of Mexico City's boroughs. It lies at an elevation of 2,365 m (7,759 ft) above sea level. As of the 2010 census, La Magdalena Contreras (Spanish pronunciation: [maɣða'lɛna kon'tɾeras]) is a borough (demarcación territorial) in Mexico City. However, urban sprawl has put pressure on these conservation areas. It is named after two historically important communities—La Magdalena Atlitc and Colonia Contreras. The northern end of the borough is urbanized. La Magdalena Contreras (Spanish pronunciation: [maɣða'lɛna kon'tɾeras]) is a borough (demarcación territorial) in Mexico City. La Merced (neighborhood) This market was established to centralize the marketing of foodstuffs for the city on one area. Over its history the area was associated with commerce, first as a major docking area for boats bringing goods to Tenochtitlan/Mexico City on Lake Texcoco, later via canals as the lake was slowly drained. In the 1980s, the wholesale function of this market was taken over by the newly constructed Centro de Abasto in the south of the city, with the barrio then going into economic and social decline, with the area having problems with poverty. In the latter 19th century, the La Merced market was established in the area replacing the massive La Merced monastery which was almost completely destroyed in the 1860s. It extends over La Merced is a barrio or a neighborhood of Mexico City defined by its socioeconomics and history rather than by an official designation. The first La Merced market was built in 1890 and then replaced by the current building in 1957, one of the largest traditional Mexican markets in Mexico City. It extends over the southeast of the historic center of Mexico City and is one of the oldest sections of the city, established over 700 years ago by the Mexica as part of the founding of Tenochtitlan.
