Gay male speech Historically, gay male speech characteristics have been highly stigmatized, so that such features were often reduced in certain settings, such as the workplace. by contrasting it with straight male speech or comparing it to female speech. Scientific research has uncovered phonetically significant features produced by many gay men and demonstrated that listeners accurately guess speakers' sexual orientation at rates greater than chance. Research does not support the notion that gay speech entirely adopts mainstream feminine speech characteristics—rather, that it selectively adopts some of

those features. There are similarities between gay male speech and the speech of other members within the LGBTQ+ community. Features of lesbian speech have also been confirmed in the 21st century, though they are far less socially noticed than features of gay male speech. Drag queen speech is a further topic of research and, while some drag queens may also identify as gay men, a description of their speech styles may not be so gender binary (gay versus straight). These impairments/disorders are identified by a... 7f325ee75d A speech impairment is characterized by difficulty in articulation of words. Examples include stuttering or problems producing particular sounds. Articulation refers to the sounds, syllables, and phonology produced by the individual. An example may include substituting one sound for another or leaving out sounds. Voice, however, may refer to the characteristics of the sounds produced—specifically, the pitch, quality, and intensity of the sound. However, some may have a mixed disorder in which both articulation and phonological problems exist. Though speech sound disorders are associated with childhood, some residual errors may persist into adulthood. Several different sources suggest that 1 to 2% of the young adult population overall continue to present with speech sound disorder errors. 7f325ee75d Telepractice is a method of reaching students and individuals in any distant location. Telepractice is defined by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) as the use of technology to provide speech therapy services to remote regions. Janet Brown, the Director of Healthcare services in SLP at ASHA has stated "research shows that with telepractice a speech-language pathologist can provide speech therapy services, with the same results, as being there in person." 7f325ee75d A lateral lisp occurs when the [s] and [z] sounds are produced with air-flow over the sides of the tongue. Apraxia of speech difficulty is limited to vocal speech, and does not affect sign-language production. The individual knows exactly what they want to say, but there is Apraxia of speech (AOS), also called verbal apraxia, is a speech sound disorder affecting an individual's ability to translate conscious speech plans into motor plans, which results in limited and difficult speech ability. By the definition of apraxia, AOS affects volitional (willful or purposeful) movement pattern. However, AOS usually also affects automatic speech

Developmental verbal dyspraxia (DVD), also known as childhood apraxia of speech (CAS) and developmental apraxia of speech (DAS), is an inability to utilize motor planning to perform movements necessary for speech during a child's language learning process. Although the causes differ between AOS and DVD, the main characteristics and treatments are similar.

Monster Study When he began studying speech pathology, he tested his own speech patterns, and the leading theory at the time suggested that stuttering had

genetic origins. It was conducted by Wendell Johnson through the University of Iowa with the physical experiment being performed by his graduate student Mary Tudor. ". Johnson, who understood the impact that early stuttering could have on a child's mental state, once stated, "The stuttering child is a crippled child. Johnson, who had a severe stutter himself, wanted to understand where it originated and how it could be stopped, largely because he had been teased throughout his life. Wendell Johnson, a former student at the University of Iowa, dedicated his life's work to identifying the causes of stuttering and discovering a cure. This The Monster Study was a non-consensual experiment performed on 22 orphan children in Davenport, Iowa in 1939 about stuttering. study was not successful and had many ethical issues, speech pathologists learned that stuttering does have initial roots that can come from learning 7f325ee75d

A frontal lisp occurs when the tongue is placed anterior to the target. Interdental lisping is produced when the tip of the tongue protrudes between the front teeth and dentalized lisping is produced when the tip of the tongue just touches the front teeth. AOS is a loss of prior speech ability resulting from a brain injury such as a stroke or progressive illness. 7f325ee75d A study in the United States estimated that among 6-year-olds, 5.3% of African-American children and 3.8% of white children have a speech sound disorder. 7f325ee75d While normally used to facilitate communication with others, people may also use speech without the intent to communicate. Speech may nevertheless express emotions or desires; people talk to themselves sometimes in acts that are a development of what some psychologists (e.g., Lev Vygotsky) have maintained is the use of silent speech in an interior monologue to vivify and organize cognition, sometimes in the momentary adoption of a dual persona as self addressing self as though addressing another person.
