

What Causes A Runny Nose

In technical terms, an allergen is an antigen that is capable of stimulating a type-I hypersensitivity reaction in atopic individuals through immunoglobulin E (IgE) responses. Most humans mount significant immunoglobulin E responses only as a defense against parasitic infections. However, some individuals may respond to many common environmental antigens. In atopic individuals, non-parasitic antigens stimulate inappropriate IgE production, leading to type I hypersensitivity. The inflammation is caused by viruses, bacteria, irritants or allergens. The most common kind of rhinitis is allergic rhinitis, which is usually triggered by airborne allergens such as pollen and dander. Allergic rhinitis may cause additional symptoms, such as sneezing and nasal itching, coughing, headache, fatigue, malaise, and cognitive impairment. The allergens may also affect the eyes, causing watery, reddened, or itchy eyes and puffiness around the eyes. The inflammation results in the generation of large amounts of mucus, commonly producing a runny nose, as well as a stuffy nose and post-nasal drip. In the case of allergic rhinitis, the inflammation is caused by the degranulation of mast cells in the nose. When mast cells degranulate, they release histamine and other chemicals, starting an inflammatory process that can

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cause symptoms outside the nose, such as fatigue and malaise. In the case of infectious rhinitis, it may occasionally lead to pneumonia, either viral or bacterial. Sneezing also occurs... 9e0600c7a4

The inhalant opens up the medium and large airways in the lungs. It is used to treat the symptoms of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and asthma. It is used by inhaler or nebulizer. Onset of action is typically within 15 to 30 minutes and lasts for three to five hours. 9e0600c7a4

Adenovirus infection nasal congestion, runny nose and abdominal pain. Onset is usually two to fourteen days after exposure to the virus. Up to Adenovirus infection is a contagious viral disease, caused by adenoviruses, commonly resulting in a respiratory tract infection. A mild eye infection may occur on its own, combined with a sore throat and fever, or as a more severe adenoviral keratoconjunctivitis with a painful red eye, intolerance to light and discharge. However, some

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people have no symptoms. There may be a harsh barking cough. Typical symptoms range from those of a common cold, such as nasal congestion, rhinitis, and cough, to difficulty breathing as in pneumonia. Very young children may just have an earache. Other general symptoms include fever, fatigue, muscle aches, headache, abdominal pain and swollen neck glands. It is frequently associated with a fever and a sore throat 9e0600c7a4

Common cold Occasionally, those with other health problems may develop pneumonia. People usually recover

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in seven to ten days, but some symptoms may last up to three weeks. When general symptoms are systemic and the disease is severe, the term "flu-like" or "influenza-like illness" can be used instead. These may include coughing, sore throat, runny nose, sneezing, headache, fatigue, and fever. Signs and symptoms may appear in as little as two days after exposure to the virus. Well over 200 virus strains are implicated in causing the common cold, with enteroviruses (especially rhinoviruses), coronaviruses, and adenoviruses being the most common. They spread through the air or indirectly through contact with objects in the environment, followed by transfer to the mouth or nose. Risk factors include going to child care facilities, not sleeping well, and psychological stress. The symptoms are mostly due to the body's immune response to the infection rather than to tissue destruction by the viruses themselves. The symptoms... 9e0600c7a4 Common side effects of inhalant use include dry mouth, cough, inflammation of the airways, and shortness of breath. Potentially serious side effects include urinary retention, worsening spasms of the airways, and a severe allergic reaction. It appears to be safe in pregnancy and breastfeeding. It is on the World Health Organization's List of Essential Medicines and is available as a generic medication. In 2023, it was the 272nd most commonly prescribed medication in the United States, with more than 800,000 prescriptions. 9e0600c7a4 Commonly used anti-allergic agents include antihistamines, decongestants, corticosteroids, leukotriene pathway modifiers and mast cell stabilizers. Antihistamines and decongestants are generally the first-line treatment in mild to moderate allergic reactions. Corticosteroids are generally indicated for moderate cases. In severe cases, adrenaline is used to reduce swelling and aid breathing. Allergen immunotherapy is an alternative treatment considered in some patients, with a success rate of 80%-90% in reducing symptoms, but requiring a much longer duration of therapy. The choice of medications depends on the disease

Cyanogen chloride This triatomic pseudohalogen is an easily condensed colorless gas. Symptoms of exposure may include drowsiness, rhinorrhea (runny nose), sore throat, coughing, confusion, nausea, vomiting, edema, loss of consciousness Cyanogen chloride is an inorganic compound with the formula ClCN. respiratory organs. More commonly encountered in the laboratory is the related compound cyanogen bromide, a room-temperature solid that is used in biochemical analysis and preparation. Adenovirus infection in humans are generally caused by Adenoviruses types B, C, E and F. Spread occurs mainly when an infected person is in close contact with another person. This may occur by either fecal-oral route, airborne transmission or small droplets containing the virus. Less commonly, the virus may spread via contaminated surfaces... 9e0600c7a4 Cyanogen chloride is a linear molecule with the connectivity $\text{Cl}-\text{C}\equiv\text{N}$, as are HCN and the related cyanogen halides (FCN, BrCN, ICN). The carbon and chlorine atoms are linked by a single bond, and carbon and nitrogen by a triple bond. It is a linear molecule. Cyanogen chloride is produced by the oxidation of sodium cyanide with chlorine. This reaction proceeds via the intermediate cyanogen ((CN)₂). 9e0600c7a4 Common side effects when used for asthma include headache, sore throat, and thrush. It is therefore recommended to rinse the mouth after use. Long-term use may increase the risk

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for glaucoma and cataracts. Common side effects when used in the nose include upper respiratory tract infections and nose bleeds. Common side effects when applied on the skin include acne, skin atrophy, and itchiness. 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others, is a type of anticholinergic medication which is applied by different routes: inhaler, nebulizer, or nasal spray, for different reasons. prevents the glands in the nose from producing large amounts of fluid

Mucus is typically produced from cells found in mucous glands, and may also originate from mixed glands which contain both serous and mucous cells. It is a viscous colloidal gel containing water (90-95%), inorganic salts, antimicrobial enzymes (such as lysozymes), antibodies especially immunoglobulin A, and glycoproteins such as lactoferrin and mucins, which are produced by goblet cells in the mucous membranes and submucosal glands. Most of the mucus in the body is produced in the gastrointestinal tract.

== Medical uses ==

The World Health Organization and International Union of Immunological Societies (WHO/IUIS) Allergen Nomenclature Sub-Committee maintains a webpage listing every protein (as well as some carbohydrates) that have elicited a confirmed IgE reaction in humans. Sensitivities vary widely from one person (or from one animal) to another. A very broad range of substances can be allergens to sensitive individuals.

Mometasone Specifically, they are used to prevent, rather than treat, asthma attacks. Currently only mometasone furoate is used in medical products. They can be applied to the skin, inhaled, or used in the nose. of mometasone for asthma may cause the following side effects: headache stuffy or runny nose dry throat swelling of nose, throat and
