Bacca began his education under the Claretians and was ordained as a priest in 1925. He continued his studies at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München, the University of Zurich, and the University of Paris. However, during the 1930s, he left the Church and pursued philosophy at the University of Barcelona. In 1936 after criticizing Francisco Franco, Bacca was forced to live in exile. He first traveled to Ecuador where he taught at the Central University of Ecuador from 1939 to 1942. While in Ecuador, he became close friends with a writer named Alfredo Pareja Diezcanseco. He then went to Mexico where he taught at the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM - Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México) from 1942 to 1946. He eventually established himself in Venezuela in 1946 and was granted citizenship in 1952. Bacca was a professor at the Central University of Venezuela until his retirement in 1971. Neoliberalism in Peru It is one of the most comprehensive and longest-lasting implementations in Latin America, due to comparatively weak political opposition to neoliberalism. Although it suffered a setback in 1998, during the 1997 Asian financial crisis, it recovered and intensified during the period of greatest economic growth, driven by the commodities boom, between 2003 and 2013. The term has multiple, competing definitions, and is often used pejoratively. Its turning point came in the 1990s with the implementation of the Fujishock, a set of drastic economic measures taken by President Alberto Fujimori inspired by the US government based on the Washington Consensus, and with the promulgation of the 1993 Political Constitution, which was heavily influenced by neoliberalism 856d4a819e

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
