Batter my heart, three-person'd God It is a part of a larger series of poems called Holy Sonnets, comprising nineteen poems in total. in a reflection "of the mind," and harsh rhythms and words like "break" or "force" "do what they say," which would be breaking the rules of the standardly "Holy Sonnet XIV" – also known by its first line as "Batter my heart, three-person'd God" – is a poem written by the English poet John Donne (1572–1631). Equine conformation Although there are several faults with universal disadvantages, a horse's conformation is usually judged according to its intended use. Ribs are adequate Equine conformation evaluates a horse's bone structure, musculature, and its body proportions in relation to each other. Undesirable conformation can limit the ability to perform a specific task. Slab-Sided Poor spring of the ribs due to flatness and vertical alignment of the ribs. between last rib and point of hip (close coupling). Thus "form to function" is one of the first set of traits considered in judging conformation. Every horse has good and bad points of conformation and many horses excel even with conformation faults. A horse with poor form for a show jumper could have excellent conformation for a cutting horse or draft horse

Schindler's family was only able to identify him by the tattoos on his arms. His killing remained front-page news throughout the spring of 1993.
