Its main function is to further break down food A monogastric organism defines one of the many types of digestive tracts found among different species of animals. A monogastric can be classified as an herbivore, an omnivore (facultative carnivore), or a carnivore (obligate carnivore). Examples of monogastric omnivores include humans, pigs, and hamsters. The defining feature of a monogastric is that it has a simple single-chambered stomach (one stomach). Examples of monogastric herbivores include horses, rabbits, and guinea pigs

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The digestive system of a monogastric is a one way tract that can be divided into two section: the foregut and the hindgut. The foregut consists of the mouth, esophagus, stomach, and small intestine. The hindgut consists of the...

There are two distinct types of tumors: benign and malignant. Both types of tumors share several general characteristics, the broadest being that they are an abnormal proliferation of cells. The main difference between the two types is what happens once the tumor has

started growing. In a benign tumor, the proliferated cells stay in one location, where they do not impact or spread to other surrounding tissues. Malignant tumors, on the other hand, are capable of spreading throughout the entire body, causing new tumors to appear. This process is called metastasis, and is a hallmark of cancerous tumors.

Symptoms are not necessarily distinguishable from other kinds of distress. A dog might stand uncomfortably and seem to be in extreme discomfort for no apparent reason. Other possible symptoms include firm distension of the abdomen, weakness, depression, difficulty breathing, hypersalivation, and retching without producing any vomitus (nonproductive vomiting). GDV is a life-threatening condition in dogs that requires prompt treatment. It is common in certain breeds; deep-chested and large dog breeds are especially at risk.

Mortality rates in dogs range from 10 to 60%, even with treatment. With surgery, the mortality rate is 15 to 33 percent.
