The male equivalent, seen primarily in ruminants, is called rut. 56374f8015 Some classification schemes provide a more comprehensive account of extinct groups (see section "Taxonomic Classification" below). The production of LH is regulated by gonadotropin-releasing hormone (GnRH) from the hypothalamus. In males, where LH had also been called interstitial cell stimulating hormone (ICSH), it stimulates Leydig cell production of testosterone. ovulation. It acts synergistically with follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH). In females, an acute rise of LH known as an LH surge, triggers ovulation and development of the corpus luteum 56374f8015

Long-acting reversible contraceptives They are the most effective reversible methods of contraception because their efficacy is not reliant on patient compliance. Side effects and risks for LARCs vary Long-acting reversible contraceptives (LARC) are methods of birth control that provide effective contraception for an extended period without requiring user action. timeframe may be extended if the date of ovulation is known; the copper IUD must be inserted within 5 days of ovulation. The failure rates of IUDs and implants is less than 1% per year. They include hormonal and non-hormonal intrauterine devices (IUDs) and subdermal hormonal contraceptive implants 56374f8015

== Scope == 56374f8015 The term luteinizing comes from the Latin "luteus", meaning "yellow". This is in reference to the corpus luteum, which is a mass of cells that forms in an ovary after an ovum (egg) has been discharged. The corpus luteum is so named because it often has a distinctive yellow color. The process of forming the corpus luteum is known as "luteinization", and thus the hormone that triggers this process is termed the "luteinizing" hormone.

56374f8015 While normal cells contain 46 chromosomes (23 pairs), gamete cells contain only half that number, and it is when these two cells merge into one combined zygote cell that genetic recombination occurs. The zygote then

These multiple follicles can be taken out by oocyte retrieval (egg collection) for use in in vitro fertilisation (IVF), or be given time to ovulate, resulting in superovulation which is the ovulation of a larger-than-normal number of eggs, generally in the sense of at least two. When ovulated follicles are fertilised in vivo, whether by natural or artificial insemination, there is a very high risk of a multiple pregnancy 56374f8015

While the normal human menstrual cycle typically lasts 4 weeks (28 days, range 24–35 days) and consists of a follicular phase, ovulation, and a luteal phase followed by either menstruation or pregnancy, the anovulatory cycle has cycle lengths of varying degrees. In many circumstances, menstrual intervals are prolonged, reaching 35–180 days (oligomenorrhea) or even longer (amenorrhea). In other cases, menstruation may be fairly regular (eumenorrhea), more frequent (intervals of less than 21 days) or there may be a loss of menstrual pattern (menorrhagia, dysfunctional uterine bleeding). 56374f8015 == Etymology == 56374f8015
