Drug test Others are intended to catch substances added to the urine to alter the A drug test (also often toxicology screen or tox screen) is a technical analysis of a biological specimen, for example urine, hair, blood, breath, sweat, or oral fluid/saliva—to determine the presence or absence of specified parent drugs or their metabolites. properties of normal urine, such as, urine creatinine, pH, and specific gravity. Major applications of drug testing include detection of the presence of performance enhancing steroids in sport, employers and parole/probation officers screening for drugs prohibited by law (such as cocaine, methamphetamine, and heroin) and police officers testing for the presence and concentration of alcohol (ethanol) in the blood commonly referred to as BAC (blood alcohol content). Numerous other methods with varying degrees of accuracy, sensitivity (detection threshold/cutoff), and detection periods exist. BAC tests are typically administered via a breathalyzer while urinalysis is used for the vast majority of drug testing in sports and the workplace 88e090920b

Urine-diverting dry toilet The separate collection of feces and urine without any flush water has many advantages, such as odor-free operation and pathogen reduction by drying. While dried feces and urine harvested from UDDTs can be and routinely are used in agriculture (respectively, as a soil amendment and nutrient-rich fertilizer—this practice being known as reuse of excreta in agriculture), many UDDT installations do not apply any sort of recovery scheme. The UDDT is an example of a technology that can be used to achieve a sustainable sanitation system. Routine testing of the urine with multiparameter strips is the first step in the diagnosis of a wide range of diseases. It may be prevented or treated by oral supplements or by injections. As a water-soluble vitamin, any riboflavin consumed in excess of nutritional requirements is not stored; it is either not absorbed or is absorbed and quickly excreted in urine, causing the urine to have a bright yellow tint. Urine plays an important role in the earth's nitrogen cycle. In balanced ecosystems, urine fertilizes the soil and thus helps plants to grow. Therefore, urine can be used as a fertilizer. Some animals mark their territories with urine. Historically, aged or fermented urine (known as lant) was also used in gunpowder production, household cleaning, leather tanning, and textile dyeing. HPLC is widely used for manufacturing (e.g., during the production process of pharmaceutical and biological products), legal (e.g., detecting performance enhancement drugs in urine), research (e.g., separating the components of a complex biological sample, or of similar synthetic chemicals from each other), and medical (e.g., detecting vitamin D levels in blood serum) purposes. The test strips consist of a ribbon made of plastic or paper of about 5 millimetre wide. Plastic strips have pads impregnated with chemicals that react with the compounds present in urine producing a characteristic colour. For the paper strips the reactants are absorbed directly onto the paper. Paper strips are often specific to a single reaction (e.g. pH measurement), while the strips with pads allow several...

In mammals, urine travels from the kidneys via the ureters to the bladder for storage until urination. Placental mammals expel urine from the bladder through the urethra, whereas other vertebrates urinate through the cloaca. HPLC is essentially a pressurized form of column chromatography, which uses pressurized pumps instead of the force of gravity, and thinner and longer columns with smaller adsorbent particles. These increase its analytic resolution.

Riboflavin The coenzymes are also required for the metabolism of niacin, vitamin B6, and folate. Urine color is used as a hydration status biomarker and, under normal conditions, correlates with urine specific gravity and urine osmolality Riboflavin, also known as vitamin B2, is a vitamin found in food and sold as a dietary supplement. excreted in urine. These coenzymes are involved in energy metabolism, cellular respiration, and antibody production, as well as normal growth and development. It is essential to the formation of two major coenzymes, flavin mononucleotide and flavin adenine dinucleotide. Riboflavin is prescribed to treat corneal thinning, and taken orally, may reduce the incidence of migraine headaches in adults

High pressure pumps force mixtures of various solvents (the mobile phase, e.g., water, buffers, acetonitrile and/or methanol) to flow through... It is heterodimeric, with an α (alpha) subunit identical to that of luteinizing hormone (LH), follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH), thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH), and a β (beta) subunit that is unique to hCG.
