Tutin was first discovered as a honey contaminant in the late 19th century. Missionaries from overseas introduced the western honey bee (*Apis mellifera*) to New Zealand in 1839. A few decades later, people eating the local honey would suffer from symptoms like vomiting, headaches and confusion. At this point the neurotoxin was studied, and in the early 1900s its toxic effects were fully characterised. The toxin was known to come from the tutu plant. Phenytoin It is useful for the prevention of tonic-clonic seizures (also known as grand mal seizures) and focal seizures, but not absence

It may also be used for certain heart arrhythmias or neuropathic pain. It can be taken intravenously or by mouth. The intravenous form generally begins working within 30 minutes and is effective for roughly 24 hours. Blood levels can be measured to determine the proper dose. Prasterone enanthate This is not a comprehensive list. These side-effects Prasterone enanthate, also known as dehydroepiandrosterone enanthate (DHEA-E) and sold in combination with estradiol valerate under the brand name Gynodian Depot among others, is a weak androgen, estrogen, and neurosteroid medication which is used as a component of menopausal hormone therapy to treat menopausal symptoms in women. The medication is given by injection into muscle typically once every 4 weeks db5bdf196a

Common side effects include orthostatic hypotension (decrease in blood pressure while standing, and associated lightheadedness), tinnitus (ringing in the ears), and photosensitivity (sensitivity to light). Potentially serious side effects include electrolyte abnormalities, low blood pressure, and hearing loss. It is recommended that serum electrolytes (especially potassium), serum CO₂, creatinine, BUN levels, and liver and kidney functioning be monitored in patients taking furosemide. It is also recommended to be alert for the occurrence of any potential blood dyscrasias. db5bdf196a

Furosemide It can be taken intravenously or orally. Furosemide may also be used for the treatment of high blood pressure. When given intravenously, furosemide typically takes effect within five minutes; when taken orally, it typically metabolizes within an hour. Potentially serious side effects include electrolyte abnormalities, low blood pressure, and hearing loss. Baclofen It is taken orally or by intrathecal pump (delivered into the spinal canal via an implantable pump device). can cause excessive toxicity. Baclofen is a potent GABAB receptor agonist, antispasmodic, and skeletal muscle relaxant used to treat chronic muscle spasms and muscle spasticity, such as from a spinal cord injury or multiple sclerosis. Serious side effects, such as seizures and rhabdomyolysis Baclofen, sold under the brand name Lioresal among others, is a central nervous system (CNS) depressant and derivative of the inhibitory neurotransmitter, gamma-Aminobutyric acid (GABA). It may also be used for hiccups and muscle spasms near the end of life, and off-label to treat alcohol use disorder or opioid withdrawal symptoms. Glutamine It is non-essential and conditionally essential in humans, meaning the body can usually synthesize sufficient amounts of it, but in some instances of stress, the body's demand for glutamine increases, and glutamine must be obtained from the diet. Its side chain is similar to that of glutamic acid, except the carboxylic acid group is replaced by an amide. Glutamine (symbol Gln or Q) is an α -amino acid that is used in the biosynthesis of proteins. Its side chain is similar to that of glutamic acid, except the carboxylic acid group is replaced by an amide. It is named after glutamic acid, which in turn is named after its discovery in cereal proteins, gluten. Tutin (toxin) It acts as a potent antagonist of the glycine receptor, and has powerful convulsant effects. It is used in scientific research into the glycine receptor. Baclofen should be avoided in the setting of chronic kidney disease and end stage renal disease as even small doses can cause excessive toxicity. Common side effects include sleepiness, weakness, and dizziness. Serious side effects, such as seizures and rhabdomyolysis, may occur if use of baclofen is stopped abruptly. It is a steroid ester and a long-lasting prodrug of prasterone (dehydroepiandrosterone; DHEA) in the body. Prasterone is a naturally occurring prohormone of androgens and estrogens and hence is an agonist of the androgen and estrogen receptors, the respective biological targets of androgens like testosterone and estrogens like estradiol. Prasterone also has a variety of activities of its own, including neurosteroid and other activities. An injection of prasterone enanthate has a duration of action in terms of elevated prasterone levels of about 18 days. db5bdf196a The medication is available in Europe, Latin America, and Egypt.
