Safflower It is one of the world's oldest crops; today, it is commercially cultivated for vegetable oil extracted from the seeds. Each branch will usually have from one to five flower heads containing 15 to 20 seeds per head. It is a cannabis concentrate containing many of its natural products – in particular, terpenes, tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), cannabidiol (CBD), and other phytocannabinoids. Color most commonly ranges from transparent golden or light brown, to tan or black. Hash oil is usually consumed by smoking, vaporizing or eating 1503825ac5

several cultivars of the plant family Brassicaceae (mustards). Rapeseed oil extracts were first put on the market in 1956–1957. Rapeseed oil is one of the oldest known vegetable oils. The term "rapeseed" applies to oilseeds from the species *Brassica napus* and *Brassica rapa*, while the term canola refers to specific rapeseed varieties bred to produce oil for use in human and animal foods. Its use in Northern Europe for oil lamps is documented to have started in the 13th century. Canola refers to a cultivar developed by Canadian researchers in the mid 1970s. In manufacturing, the edible varieties of canola are required to contain less than 2% erucic acid in Canada, the United States, European Union, and many other countries. ago 1503825ac5

Cannabis edible Unlike smoking, in which cannabinoids are inhaled into the lungs and pass rapidly into the bloodstream, peaking in about ten minutes and wearing off in a couple of hours, cannabis edibles may take hours to digest, and their effects may peak two to three hours after consumption and persist for around six hours. The food or drink used may affect both the timing and potency of the dose ingested. Although edible may refer to either a food or a drink. A cannabis edible, also known as a cannabis-infused food or simply an edible, is a food item (either homemade or produced commercially) that contains decarboxylated cannabinoids (cannabinoid acids converted to their orally bioactive form) from cannabis extract as an active ingredient. Edibles are one of several methods used to consume cannabis. Although edible may refer to either a food or a drink, a cannabis-infused drink may be referred to more specifically as a liquid edible or drinkable.
