Lysacek won the title on the first tiebreak under International Skating Union rules... 3eee9736b5 Ladies gold medalist Mirai Nagasu, silver medalist Rachael Flatt, and pewter medalist Caroline Zhang were not placed on the World or Four Continents team because they were not age-eligible. 3eee9736b5 == Competition format == 3eee9736b5 Each skater had to complete a set of compulsory figures, with a possible score from those figures of 168. There were 5 figures which had to be completed in both directions and 1 figure that was completed in only one direction (resulting in a total of 11 figures). Each figure was repeated three times. Marks were given for each figure from 0 to 6 (in half-point increments), then multiplied by a difficulty factor for that figure. 3eee9736b5 == Military models == 3eee9736b5 Model figures are sold both as kits for enthusiasts to construct and paint and as pre-built, pre-painted collectable figurines. From intermediate through senior-level competition, skaters generally perform two programs (the short program and the free skate), which, depending on the discipline, may include spins, jumps, moves in the field, lifts, throw jumps, death spirals, and other elements or moves. Figure skating is a sport in which individuals, pairs, or groups perform jumps, spins, and dance moves on ice. Their footwear are figure skates. It was the first winter sport to be included in the Olympic Games, with its introduction occurring at the 1908 Olympics in London. The non-Olympic

disciplines include synchronized skating, Theater on Ice, and four skating. Their footwear are figure skates. The Olympic disciplines are men's singles, women's singles, pair skating, and ice dance; the four individual disciplines are also combined into a team event, which was first included in the Winter Olympics in 2014 3eee9736b5

The free skating winner was Sergei Chetverukhin, who skated one of his best performances at this event to take the silver medal. Patrick Péra, second in the figures, had a poor free skating in which he fell on a triple salchow jump early in his program and then made other mistakes.
