Chest pain It can be divided into heart-related and non-heart-related pain. Associated symptoms may include pain in the shoulder, arm, upper abdomen, or jaw, along with nausea, sweating, or shortness of breath. Pain due to insufficient blood flow to the heart is also called angina pectoris. Studies have confirmed that there is convergence Chest pain is pain or discomfort in the chest, typically the front of the chest. It may be described as sharp, dull, pressure, heaviness or squeezing. Those with diabetes or the elderly may have less clear symptoms. Gallbladder disease is also notorious in causing referred chest pain, as well as pain in the abdomen and back 41c4461e19

A stent is different from a shunt. A shunt is a tube that connects two previously unconnected parts of the body to allow fluid to flow between them. Stents and shunts can be made of similar materials, but perform two different tasks. 41c4461e19

Cholecystitis Without appropriate treatment, recurrent episodes of cholecystitis are common. Symptoms include right upper abdominal pain, pain in the right shoulder, nausea, vomiting, and occasionally fever. Taking pictures of the bile ducts during the surgery is recommended. Complications of acute cholecystitis include gallstone pancreatitis, common bile duct stones, or inflammation of the common bile duct. The routine Cholecystitis () is inflammation of the gallbladder. The pain lasts longer in cholecystitis than in a typical gallbladder attack. Often gallbladder attacks (biliary colic) precede acute cholecystitis. usually with laparoscopic gallbladder removal, within 24 hours if possible 41c4461e19

== Working principle == 41c4461e19 More than 90% of the time acute cholecystitis is caused from blockage of the cystic duct by a gallstone. Risk factors for gallstones include birth control pills, pregnancy, a family history of gallstones, obesity, diabetes, liver disease, or rapid weight loss. Occasionally, acute cholecystitis occurs as a result of vasculitis or chemotherapy, or during recovery from major trauma or burns. Cholecystitis is suspected based on symptoms and laboratory testing. Abdominal ultrasound is then typically used to confirm the diagnosis. 41c4461e19 Serious and relatively common causes include acute coronary syndrome such as a heart attack (31%), pulmonary embolism (2%), pneumothorax, pericarditis (4%), aortic dissection (1%) and esophageal rupture. Other common causes include gastroesophageal reflux disease (30%), muscle or skeletal pain (28%), pneumonia (2%), shingles (0.5%), pleuritis, traumatic and anxiety disorders. Determining the cause of chest pain is based on a person's medical history, a physical exam and other medical tests. About 3% of heart attacks, however, are initially missed. 41c4461e19 == History == 41c4461e19 Stenting refers to the placement of a stent.
