In the 1980s people using ESWT for kidney stones noticed that it appeared to increase bone density in nearby bones, leading them to explore it for orthopedic purposes. Beginning in 1969, funded by the German Ministry of Defense, Dornier began a study of the effects of shock waves on tissue. In 1972, on the basis of Dornier's preliminary studies, an agreement was reached with Egbert Schmiedt, director of the urologic clinic at LMU Munich. The development of the Dornier lithotripter progressed through prototypes, culminating in February 1980 with the first treatment of a human. The production and distribution of the Dornier HM3 lithotripter began in late 1983, and ESWT was approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration in 1984.

The cause of plantar fasciitis is not clear. Risk factors include overuse, such as from long periods of standing, an increase in exercise, and obesity. It is associated with inward rolling of the foot, a tight calf muscle and Achilles tendon, and a sedentary lifestyle. Heel spurs may play a role; they are commonly present in people who have the condition. Plantar fasciitis is a disorder of the insertion site of the ligament on the bone characterized by micro tears, collagen breakdown, and scarring. Inflammation plays either a lesser or no role.
