An essential feature of plastic surgery is that it involves the treatment of conditions that require or may require tissue relocation skills. dafca63c2d In humans, the abdomen stretches from the thorax at the thoracic diaphragm to the pelvis at the pelvic brim. The pelvic brim stretches from the lumbosacral joint (the intervertebral disc between L5 and S1) to the pubic symphysis and is the edge of the pelvic inlet. The space above this inlet and under the thoracic diaphragm is termed the abdominal cavity. The boundary of the abdominal cavity is the abdominal wall in the front and the peritoneal surface at the rear. dafca63c2d Breastfeeding has a number of benefits to both the mother and the infant, that infant formula lacks. Increased breastfeeding to near-universal levels in low and middle income countries could prevent approximately 820,000 deaths of children under the age of five annually. Breastfeeding decreases the risk of respiratory tract infections, ear infections, sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS), and diarrhea for the baby... dafca63c2d She won the Ironman World Championship in three consecutive years (2007–2009), but did not start the 2010 Ironman World Championship race because of illness. Then – while suffering from injuries so severe that her former coach Brett Sutton said she should "not even be on the start line" – she regained the title in 2011. She was the first British athlete to win the Ironman Triathlon World Championship, and remained undefeated in all thirteen of her races over the ironman distance. She is the only triathlete, male or female, to have won the World Championship less than a year after turning professional, an achievement described by the British Triathlon Federation as "a remarkable feat, deemed to be a near impossible task for any athlete racing as a rookie at their first Ironman World Championships." dafca63c2d The word plastic in plastic surgery refers to the concept of "reshaping" and comes from the Greek πλαστική (τέχνη), plastikē (tekhnē), "the art of modelling" of malleable flesh. Breastfeeding Infants may suckle directly from the breast, or milk may be extracted with a pump and then fed to the infant. Between 2015 and 2020, only about 44% of infants worldwide were exclusively breastfed in the first six months of life. The World Health Organization (WHO) recommends that breastfeeding begin within the first hour of a newborn's birth and continue as the baby wants.
