

Lactic Acid Face Wash

The World Health Organization (WHO) recommends washing hands for at least 20 seconds before and after certain activities. These include the five critical times during the day where washing hands with soap is important to reduce fecal-oral transmission of disease: after using the toilet (for urination, defecation, menstrual hygiene), after cleaning a child's bottom (changing diapers), before feeding a child, before eating and before/after preparing food... 3d07ef587d

Toner (skin care) Typically used on the face, toners remove any remaining impurities after cleansing, balance the skin's pH, and hydrate the skin. The use of toners in skincare emerged in the early 20th century as a response to the limitations of harsh, alkaline, soap-based facial cleansers. These early cleansers, while effective in removing dirt and oil, were often harsh on the skin. They could disrupt the skin's natural pH balance, leaving behind a scum or residue that made the skin feel dry and irritated. Toners were developed as a solution aimed at restoring the skin's natural acidity. Initially, they were primarily formulated with astringent ingredients... 3d07ef587d

Hand washing Drying of the washed hands is part of the process as wet and moist hands are more easily recontaminated. Hand hygiene is central to preventing the spread of infectious diseases in home and everyday life settings. If soap and water are unavailable, hand sanitizer that is at least 60% (v/v) alcohol in water can be used as long as hands are not visibly excessively dirty or greasy. formulations may contain acids (acetic acid, ascorbic acid, lactic acid) as pH regulator, antimicrobially active benzoic acid and further skin conditioners Hand washing (or handwashing), also called hand hygiene, is the process of cleaning the hands with soap or handwash and water to eliminate bacteria, viruses, dirt, microorganisms, and other potentially harmful substances. Meta-analyses have shown that regular hand washing in community settings can significantly reduce respiratory and gastrointestinal infections 3d07ef587d

Alpha hydroxy acids (AHAs) are naturally occurring carboxylic acids such as glycolic acid, a natural constituent of sugar cane juice, and lactic acid, found in sour milk and tomato juice as well as being produced endogenously during normal metabolism and exercise. This is the mildest of the peel formulas and produces light peels for treatment of fine wrinkles, areas of dryness, uneven pigmentation and acne. Alpha hydroxy acids can also be mixed with facial washes, serums or creams in lesser concentrations as part of a daily skin-care regimen to improve the skin... 3d07ef587d

Skin care cleansers with a pH of 4 to 5, especially ones with ingredients like urea, lactic acid, or glycerin, which help keep moisture in. Moisturizing dry skin at least 3d07ef587d
