

Abdominal Cramping On Left Side

Bloating Bloating can affect anyone of any age range and is usually self-diagnosed. Although the term bloating is usually used interchangeably with abdominal distension, these symptoms probably have different pathophysiological processes, which are not fully understood. Bloating is generally characterized by an excess buildup of gas, air or fluids in the stomach. In most cases it does not require serious medical attention or treatment. A person may have feelings of tightness, pressure or fullness in the stomach; it may or may not be accompanied by a visibly distended abdomen cbe2196751

Diverticula typically occur in the sigmoid colon, which is commonplace for increased pressure. The left side of the colon is more commonly affected in the United States while the right side is more commonly affected in Asia. Diagnosis is often during routine colonoscopy or as an incidental finding during CT scan. cbe2196751

Sigmoidoscopy There are two types of sigmoidoscopy: flexible sigmoidoscopy, which uses a flexible endoscope, and rigid sigmoidoscopy, which uses a rigid device. A sigmoidoscopy only examines up to the sigmoid, the most distal part of the colon, while colonoscopy examines the whole large bowel. Flexible sigmoidoscopy is generally the preferred procedure. the rectum to the left side of the colon, called the sigmoid. Physicians may use the procedure to find the cause of diarrhea, abdominal pain, or constipation Sigmoidoscopy ("sigma", the Greek term for letter "s/ς" + "eidos" + "scopy": namely, to look inside an "s"/"ς"-like object) is the minimally invasive medical examination of the large intestine from the rectum through to the nearest part of the colon, the sigmoid colon. A sigmoidoscopy is similar to, but not the same as, a colonoscopy cbe2196751

The first step for management is to find a treatment for the underlying causes that produce it through a detailed medical history and a physical examination. Proctalgia fugax It can be caused by cramping of the levator ani muscle, particularly in the pubococcygeal part. episodic pain in the regions of the rectum and anus. The cbe2196751

Fecal impaction Osmotic laxatives can cause cramping and even severe pain as the patient's attempts to evacuate the contents. may not be sufficient to expel the stool cbe2196751

Ureter genitofemoral nerve. In the lower part of the. The inferior vena cava and the abdominal aorta sit to the midline of the right and left ureters, respectively cbe2196751

Gastroenterology A procedure. Complications can include bloating, cramping, reaction to anesthesia, bleeding, and perforation of the colon. followed by a brief observation period cbe2196751

Diverticulosis populations. Diverticula do not cause symptoms in most people. Some people with diverticulosis complain of symptoms such as cramping, bloating, flatulence, and irregular defecation. Diverticular disease occurs when diverticula become clinically inflamed, a condition known as diverticulitis. However, it is unclear Diverticulosis is the condition of having multiple pouches (diverticula) in the colon that are not inflamed. These are outpockets of the colonic mucosa and submucosa through weaknesses of muscle layers in the colon wall cbe2196751

The most common symptoms of RLP are: cbe2196751 It is common in Western countries with about half of those over the age of 60 affected in Canada and the United States. Diverticula are uncommon before the age of 40, and increase in incidence beyond that age. Rates are lower in Africa; the reasons for this remain unclear but may involve the greater prevalence of a high fiber diet in contrast with the lower-fiber diet characteristic of many Western populations. cbe2196751 Flexible sigmoidoscopy enables the physician to look at the inside of the large intestine from the rectum to the left side of the colon, called the sigmoid. Physicians may use the procedure to find the cause of diarrhea, abdominal pain, or constipation. They also use it to look for benign and malignant polyps, as well as early signs of cancer in the descending colon and rectum. With flexible sigmoidoscopy, the physician can see intestinal bleeding, inflammation, abnormal growths, and ulcers... cbe2196751

Causes of cancer pain cancer, and can produce severe burning dysesthetic pain on the back of the hand, and cramping, crushing forearm pain. Invasion

Round ligament pain It usually resolves completely after delivery although cases of postpartum RLP (that is, RLP that persisted for a few days after delivery) have been reported. RLP also occurs in nonpregnant women. the lower abdomen, usually in the right side of the pelvic area that can extend to the groin. RLP is one of the most common discomforts of pregnancy and usually starts at the second trimester of gestation and continues until delivery. Shooting abdominal pain when performing sudden movements or Round ligament pain (RLP) is pain associated with the round ligament of the uterus, usually during pregnancy cbe2196751

== Symptoms and signs == cbe2196751 The round ligament of the uterus goes from the pelvis, passes through the internal abdominal ring, and runs along the inguinal canal to the labia majora. It is the structure that holds the uterus suspended inside the abdominal cavity. There are at least 2 other round ligaments in the human body, the round ligament of the liver (ligamentum teres hepatis) and the round ligament of the head of the femur (ligamentum teres femoris). cbe2196751

Salgo v. Leland Stanford Jr. University Board of Trustees University Board of Trustees was a 1957 court case that helped to establish what the practice of informed consent was supposed to look like in the practice of modern medicine. This was evaluated with respect to the California Court of Appeals case where Martin Salgo sued the trustees of Stanford University and Stanford physician Dr. Frank Gerbode for malpractice as he claimed that they did not inform him nor his family of the details and risks associated with an aortogram which left him permanently paralyzed in his lower extremities. Leland Stanford Jr. physician with complaints of a limp caused by cramping in his legs, mainly calves, in addition to right side abdominal pain and discomfort in his lower back and Salgo v cbe2196751

The decision in Salgo v. Leland Stanford Jr. University Board of Trustees coined the term "informed consent" in addition to helping to establish what informed consent should look like in modern day practice. At the time, the concept of informed consent was relatively new with the first court cases helping to distinguish it coming to light in the early 20th century. This caused a shift in the idea of what role a physician upheld for their patients from protecting them from harm (physician-advocate) to becoming an advocate for their patient (patient advocate), helping and providing them with the necessary information to make an... cbe2196751 == Signs and symptoms == cbe2196751 Bloating can also be caused by chronic conditions and in rare
