

Inner Thigh Aching Pain

Abdominal internal oblique muscle – A muscle of the abdominal wall, which lies below the external oblique and just above the transverse abdominal muscles. 71f1fabb90

Bubonic plague Acral necrosis, the dark discoloration of skin, is another symptom. These symptoms include fever, headaches, and vomiting, as well as swollen and painful lymph nodes occurring in the area closest to where the bacteria entered the skin. Occasionally, swollen lymph nodes, known as "buboes", may break open. breathing, continuous vomiting of blood (hematemesis), aching limbs, coughing, and extreme pain caused by the decay or decomposition of the skin while Bubonic plague is one of three types of plague caused by the bacterium *Yersinia pestis*. One to seven days after exposure to the bacteria, flu-like symptoms develop 71f1fabb90

The three types of plague are the result of the route of infection: bubonic plague, septicemic plague, and pneumonic plague. Bubonic plague is mainly spread by infected fleas from small animals. It may also result from exposure to the body fluids from a dead plague-infected animal. Mammals such as rabbits, hares, and some cat species are susceptible to bubonic plague, and typically die upon contraction. In the bubonic form of plague, the bacteria enter through the skin through a flea bite and travel via the lymphatic vessels to a lymph node, causing it to swell. Reported symptoms included pain, paresthesia, numbness (e. , of the penis, thigh, buttocks, rectum, or vagina), urinary incontinence Tarlov cysts, also known as perineural cysts, are cerebrospinal fluid (CSF)-filled lesions that most commonly develop in the sacral region of the spinal canal (S1-S5), and less frequently in the cervical, thoracic, or lumbar spine. This involvement of neural elements distinguishes Tarlov cysts from other extradural meningeal cysts, such as meningeal diverticula, which do not contain nerve fibers. various techniques. These cysts form as dilations of the nerve root sheath near the dorsal root ganglion, specifically within the perineural space between the endoneurium and perineurium 71f1fabb90

Genital herpes Onset is typically around 4 days after exposure with symptoms lasting up to 4 weeks. In females, lesions appear on or near the pubis, Genital herpes is a herpes infection of the genitals caused by the herpes simplex virus (HSV). Flu-like symptoms, such as fever, aching, or swollen lymph nodes, may also occur. Once infected further outbreaks may occur but are generally milder. Aarskog-Scott syndrome – (AAS) A rare, inherited (X-linked) disease characterized by short stature, facial abnormalities, skeletal and genital anomalies.

and ventral (abdominal) wall. Groin hernia includes femoral, obturator, and inguinal. Inguinal hernia is the most common type of hernia and consist of about 75% of all hernia surgery cases in the US. Inguinal hernia, which results from lower abdominal wall weakness or defect, is more common among men with about 90% of total cases. In the inguinal hernia, fatty tissue or a part of the small intestine gets inserted into the inguinal canal. Other structures that are uncommon but may get stuck in inguinal hernia can be the appendix, caecum, and transverse colon. Hernias can be asymptomatic, incarcerated, or strangled. Incarcerated hernia leads to impairment of intestinal flow, and strangled hernia obstructs blood flow in addition to intestinal flow. 71f1fabb90 Abscess – A collection of pus that has built up within the tissue of the body. 71f1fabb90 The prevalence and practice of foot binding varied over time, by region, and by social class. The practice may have originated among court dancers during the Five Dynasties and Ten Kingdoms period in 10th-century China and gradually became popular among the elite during the Song dynasty, later spreading to lower social classes by the Qing dynasty (1644–1912). Manchu emperors attempted to ban the practice in the 17th century but failed. In some areas, foot binding raised marriage prospects. It has been estimated that by the 19th century 40–50% of all Chinese women may have had bound feet, rising to almost 100% among upper-class Han Chinese women. While typically not painful, some aching or itching, or pain, may be present. It is named after Guillaume Dupuytren, who first described the underlying mechanism of action, followed by the first successful operation in

1831 and publication of the results in The Lancet in 1834. The ring finger followed by the little and middle fingers are most commonly affected. It usually begins as small, hard nodules just under the skin of the palm, then worsens over time until the fingers can no longer be fully straightened. It can affect one or both hands. The condition can interfere with activities such as preparing food, writing, putting the hand in a tight pocket, putting on gloves, or shaking hands. The etiology of these cysts is not well understood; some current theories explaining this phenomenon include increased spinal fluid pressure, filling of congenital cysts with one-way valves, and/or inflammation in response to trauma and disease. The majority of back pain is nonspecific and idiopathic. Common underlying mechanisms include degenerative or traumatic changes to the discs and facet joints, which can then cause secondary pain in the muscles and nerves and referred pain to the bones, joints and extremities. Diseases and inflammation of the gallbladder, pancreas, aorta and kidneys may also cause referred pain in the back. Its major function is to abduct the thumb at the wrist. 71f1fabb90 Pudendal neuralgia refers to neuropathic pain along the course of the pudendal nerve and in its distribution. This term is often used interchangeably with pudendal nerve entrapment. However, it has been suggested that the presence of symptoms of pudendal neuralgia alone should not be used to diagnose pudendal nerve entrapment. That is because it is possible to have all the symptoms of pudendal nerve entrapment, as per the diagnostic criteria specified at Nantes in 2006, without actually having an entrapped pudendal nerve. 71f1fabb90 Abdominal external oblique muscle - The largest, and outermost, of the three flat muscles of the lateral anterior abdominal wall. 71f1fabb90 These cysts are often detected incidentally during MRI or CT scans for other medical conditions.
