Heroin is typically injected, usually into a vein, but it can also be snorted, smoked, or inhaled. In a clinical context, the route of administration is most commonly intravenous injection; it may also be given by intramuscular or subcutaneous injection, as well as orally in the form of tablets. The onset of effects is usually rapid and lasts for a few hours.

5b282fb14c Paracetamol relieves pain in acute mild migraine and episodic tension headaches. At a standard dose, paracetamol slightly reduces fever, though it is inferior to ibuprofen in that respect: the benefits of its use for fever are unclear, particularly in the context of fever of viral origins. Paracetamol is effective for pain after wisdom tooth extraction, but it is less effective than ibuprofen. The combination of paracetamol and ibuprofen provides greater analgesic efficacy than either drug alone. The pain relief paracetamol provides in osteoarthritis is small and clinically insignificant. Evidence supporting its use in low back pain, cancer pain, and neuropathic pain is insufficient.

Paracetamol is the first-line treatment for pain and fever in pregnancy; no causal association with neurodevelopmental disorders has been established, while untreated pain and fever can harm the mother and fetus. 5b282fb14c During World War II, amphetamine

and methamphetamine were used extensively by Allied and Axis forces for their stimulant and performance-enhancing effects. As the addictive properties of the drugs became known, governments began to place strict controls on these drugs. On October 27, 1970, with the enactment of the Controlled Substances Act, amphetamine was made a Schedule III controlled substance in the United States, but it was later moved to Schedule II.

Codeine Codeine exhibits abuse potential similar to other opioid medications, including a risk of addiction and overdose. In Europe, it is not recommended as a cough medicine for those under 12 years of age. It is commonly used as a recreational drug. Evidence does not support its use for acute cough suppression in children. Its effects last for about four to six hours. It usually starts working after half an hour, with maximum effect at two hours. products containing combinations of up to 12. 8 mg of codeine per dosage unit, combined with paracetamol, ibuprofen or aspirin are available over the counter at Codeine is an opiate and prodrug of morphine mainly used to treat pain, coughing, and diarrhea. It is generally taken orally. Greater benefit may occur when combined with paracetamol (acetaminophen) as codeine/paracetamol or a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) such as aspirin or ibuprofen. It is typically used to treat mild to moderate degrees of pain. It is found naturally in the sap of the opium poppy, *Papaver somniferum*

These are followed by suppository (anal or vaginal insertion), insufflation (snorting), and ingestion (swallowing) Heroin, also known as diacetylmorphine and diamorphine among other names, is a morphinan opioid substance synthesized from the dried latex of the opium poppy; it is mainly used as a recreational drug for its euphoric effects. Heroin is used medically in several countries to relieve pain, such as during childbirth or a heart attack. While not recommended in women who are breastfeeding, those who take a single dose should not generally have to stop breastfeeding. Amphetamine was first synthesized in 1887 in Germany by Romanian chemist Lazăr Edeleanu, who named it phenylisopropylamine. This is followed by suppository, insufflation, and oral administration. Opium Approximately 12 percent of opium is made up of the analgesic alkaloid morphine, which is processed chemically to produce heroin and other synthetic opioids for medicinal use and for the illegal drug trade. Opium's main psychoactive alkaloids, primarily morphine, act on μ -opioid receptors, causing analgesia, with long-term use leading to tolerance and dependence. Opium Opium (also known as poppy tears, or *Lachryma papaveris*) is the dried latex obtained from the seed capsules of the opium poppy *Papaver somniferum*. The latex also contains the closely related opiates codeine and thebaine, and non-analgesic alkaloids such as papaverine and noscapine. The traditional, labor-intensive method of obtaining the latex is to scratch ("score") the immature seed pods (fruits) by hand; The latex leaks out and dries to a sticky yellowish residue that is later scraped off and dehydrated. opium was consumed in several ways, including inhalation of vapors, suppositories, medical poultices, and as a combination with hemlock for suicide
