Los Lobos' version of "La Bamba" became the first one to reach the number 1 spot in 1987. Gente de Zona was founded in 2000 in the Alamar neighborhood of Havana, consisting initially of Alexander Delgado and Michel Delgado. They initially performed at smaller events and parties in the Havana area, including Alamar, Regla and Guanabacoa. Two years later, they joined the Asociación Hermanos Saíz, a government-sponsored Cuban cultural organization, and signed with the Empresa Comercializadora de la Música y los Espectáculos Antonio María Romeu (Commercial Business of...
