Consumable electricity is not freely available in nature, so it must be "produced", transforming other forms of energy to electricity. Production is carried out in power stations, also called "power plants". Electricity is most often generated at a power plant by electromechanical generators, primarily driven by heat engines fueled by combustion or nuclear fission, but also by other means such as the kinetic energy of flowing water and wind. Other energy sources include solar photovoltaics and geothermal power. There are exotic and speculative methods to recover energy, such as proposed fusion reactor designs which aim to directly extract energy from intense magnetic fields generated by fast-moving charged particles generated by the fusion reaction (see magnetohydrodynamics). e8715c7519 As of 2022, 95% of Pakistan's population had access to electricity. Electricity sector in Pakistan As of 2025, the Government of Pakistan is focusing to re-structure the agreements with IPPs and facilitate the end users. Currently, there are 12 distribution companies and a National Transmission And Dispatch Company (NTDC) which are all in the public sector except Karachi Electric operating in the city of Karachi and its surrounding areas. There were around 36 independent power producers (IPPs) that contribute significantly to the electricity generation in Pakistan. However demand is projected to increase considerably due to electrification, such as heat pumps and electric vehicles. e8715c7519 It was established on 1 January 1958 to assume the functions of the Central Electricity Authority (1955-1957), which had in turn replaced the British Electricity Authority (1948-1955). The Electricity Council was also established in January 1958, as the coordinating and policy-making body for the British electricity supply industry. e8715c7519 The appointment of chairmen and members of the BEA and the area boards were made in August 1947 and

the BEA was formally established on 15 August 1947. The 14 area boards were formally established on 1 January 1948, and Vesting Day, when the BEA and area boards became responsible for electricity supply, was on 1 April 1948.
