Classically, the ghazal inhabits the consciousness of a passionate, desperate lover, wherein deeper reflections of life are found in the audience's awareness of what some commentators and historians call "The Ghazal Universe", which can be described as a store of characters, settings, and other tropes the genre employs to create meaning. Until the advent of free verse in the 20th century, Persian poetry was strictly quantitative. Since short vowels are not written in the Persian script, a knowledge of metre is often essential for correct recitation and meaning resolution. He hailed from Lucknow. He completed his BSc and MSc in Botany from University of Lucknow. Zia Fatehabadi's father was an exponent of Indian Classical vocal and instrumental music, who often invited musicians and singers to his residence, was himself fond of singing and playing musical instruments, and a good player of chess. It was one such evening in Jaipur when the young school-going Zia Fatehabadi was not given by the invited singer a copy of Iqbal's ghazal that had been liked and wanted by him; this particular incident probably... == Biography == Born in the Punjab Province, Faiz studied at Government College and Oriental College in Lahore and went on to serve in the British Indian Army. After the Partition of India, Faiz served as editor-in-chief of two major newspapers — the English language daily Pakistan Times and the Urdu Daily Imroze. He was also a leading member of

They are often described as being individual pearls that make up a united necklace. fe55ecf198 == Early life == fe55ecf198 Historically, the formal analysis and terminology of Persian metres are derived from the Arabic ‘arūḍ system, established by Al-Khalil ibn Ahmad al-Farahidi in the 8th century. Persian prosodists adapted this descriptive framework to fit the distinct phonetic structures of the Persian language. It has recently been argued, however, that although Persian metres are traditionally given Arabic names, they are an independent development and not merely imitations of Arabic ones. fe55ecf198 Known for her discipline, Mangeshkar always recorded her songs barefoot as a mark of respect for the recording studio, which she considered a temple. Despite her perfectionism, she famously never listened to her own songs after their release, stating in interviews that she would only find mistakes in her singing. fe55ecf198 Born Akhtaribai Faizabadi, she began her career as a mehfil singer and became famous when she sang at the Bihar earthquake music conference in 1934. On the basis of her popularity, she received offers to appear in films, starting her career with Ek Din Ka Badshah and Nal Damayanti (1933), produced by the East India Company, in Calcutta. Talat was the eldest among her siblings. She completed her studies (FA) in her hometown. Talat's father, named Nazir Ahmad, was a government servant. fe55ecf198 Akhtar's performances were in the nature of a classical presentation, with the accompaniment of the tabla, sitar, and harmonium.
