

Soreness Upper Left Abdomen

Fine-needle aspiration less traumatic than an open biopsy; complications beyond bruising and soreness are rare. However, the few problematic cells can be too few (inconclusive)

Gastritis Autoimmune atrophic gastritis may lead to issues including pernicious anemia. There may be no symptoms, but the most common symptom is upper abdominal pain. Complications may include stomach bleeding, stomach ulcers, and stomach tumors. It may occur as a short episode or have a long duration. Other symptoms include nausea and vomiting, bloating, indigestion, loss of appetite and heartburn. Other Gastritis is the inflammation of the lining of the stomach. usually located in the upper central portion of the abdomen, but it may occur anywhere from the upper left portion of the abdomen around to the back

Trachea At the top of the trachea, the cricoid cartilage attaches it to the larynx. The trachea is formed by a number of horseshoe-shaped rings, joined together vertically by overlying ligaments, and by the trachealis muscle at their ends. Evania appendigaster petiole, the constricted stalk that holds the posterior section of the abdomen, or gaster, is attached high on the body. The gaster is laterally compressed

The trachea begins to form in the second month of embryo development, becoming longer and more fixed in its position over time. Its epithelium is lined with column-shaped cells that have hair-like extensions called cilia, with scattered goblet cells that produce protective mucins. The trachea can be affected by inflammation or infection, usually as a result of a viral illness affecting other parts of the respiratory tract, such as the larynx and bronchi, called croup, that can result in a cough. Infection with bacteria usually affects the trachea only and can cause narrowing or... Common causes include infection with Helicobacter pylori and use of nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs). Other causes include alcohol, smoking, cocaine, severe illness, autoimmune problems, radiation therapy and Crohn's disease. Endoscopy, a type of X-ray known as an upper gastrointestinal series, blood tests, and stool tests may help with diagnosis. Other conditions with similar symptoms include inflammation of the pancreas, gallbladder problems, and peptic ulcer disease.
