Energetically modified cement Energetically modified cements (EMCs) are a class of cements made from pozzolans (e. fly ash, volcanic ash, pozzolana), silica sand, blast furnace slag, or Portland cement (or blends of these ingredients). At its simplest this means a milling method that invokes high kinetics by subjecting "powders to the repeated action of hitting balls" as compared to (say) the low kinetics of rotating ball mills. g. This causes, amongst others, a thermodynamic transformation in the material to increase its chemical reactivity. Hydraulic cements such as Portland cement set and become adhesive through a chemical reaction between the dry ingredients and water. The chemical reaction results in mineral hydrates that are not very water-soluble. This allows setting in wet conditions or under water and further protects the hardened material from chemical attack. The chemical process for hydraulic cement was found by ancient Romans who used volcanic ash (pozzolana) with added lime (calcium oxide). The burnt nodules are ground to a fine powder. This product, made into a mortar with sand, sets in 5-15 minutes.
