As of February 2023, there are 85.16 million internet users in the country, where internet penetration stood at 73.1% of the total population. Internet connections in the United States are largely provided by the private sector and are available in a variety of forms, using a variety of technologies, at a wide range of speeds and costs. In 2001, half of U.S. households had internet access. In September 2007, a majority of U.S. survey respondents reported having broadband internet at home. In 2019, the United States ranked 3rd in the world for the number of internet users (behind China and India), with 312.32 million users. As of 2024, 96% of adults in America use the internet. The United States ranks #1 in the world with 7,000 Internet service providers (ISPs) according to the CIA. Internet bandwidth per Internet user was the 43rd highest in the world in 2016.
