The choice of functions for the canonical set can be biased toward specific types of patterns and regularities. For example, periodic functions such as sine produce segmented patterns with repetitions, while symmetric functions such as Gaussian produce symmetric patterns. Linear functions can be employed to produce linear or fractal-like patterns. Evolutionary acquisition of neural topologies Similar to the work of Stanley (NEAT), the method starts with minimal structures which gain complexity along the evolution path. It is closely related to the works of Angeline et al. and Stanley and Miikkulainen. Like the work of Angeline et al. , the method uses a type of parametric mutation that comes from evolution strategies and evolutionary programming (now using the most advanced form of the evolution strategies CMA-ES in EANT2), in which adaptive step sizes are used for optimizing the weights of the neural networks.
