It appears as small reddish welts that become visible in response to increased temperature and resulting production of sweat. The protein MGL_1304 secreted by mycobiota (fungi) present on the skin such as *Malassezia globosa* acts as a histamine or antigen. The allergy is not due to the sweat itself but instead to an allergy-producing protein secreted by microorganisms found on the skin. Sweating can trigger intense itching or cholinergic urticaria 91bd009b1d

The nut shell and raw seed are toxic, but the nut is edible once shelled and roasted or steamed. Treated cashews are eaten on their own as a snack, used in recipes, or processed into cashew cheese or cashew butter. The cashew apple, an accessory fruit, is a light reddish to yellow fruit,

== Signs and symptoms == Common foods involved include cow's milk, peanuts, eggs, shellfish, fish, tree nuts, soy, wheat, and sesame. The common allergies vary depending on the country. Risk factors include a family history of allergies, vitamin D deficiency, obesity, and high levels of cleanliness. Allergies occur when immunoglobulin E (IgE), part of the body's immune

system, binds to molecules in food, usually proteins. This triggers the release of inflammatory chemicals such as histamine. Diagnosis is usually based on a medical history, elimination diet, skin prick test, blood tests for food-specific IgE antibodies, or oral food challenge. 91bd009b1d

Peanut allergy Symptoms Peanut allergy is a type of food allergy to peanuts. Allergic symptoms can involve the skin (hives, swelling), gastrointestinal (vomiting, diarrhea), respiratory system (cough, wheeze) or cardiovascular system (drop in blood pressure, shock). Symptoms of allergic reaction typically occur within 2 hours of peanut ingestion. It is different from tree nut allergies, because peanuts are legumes and not true nuts. Common allergens include pollen, certain foods, metals, insect stings, medications, and materials, such as latex. The development of allergies is due to genetic and environmental factors. The mechanism of allergic reactions involves immunoglobulin E antibodies (IgE) binding to an allergen and then to a receptor on mast cells or basophils, where they trigger the release of inflammatory chemicals such as histamine. Diagnosis is typically based on a person's medical history. Further testing of the skin or blood may be useful in certain cases. Positive tests, however, may not necessarily mean there is a significant allergy to the substance in question. 91bd009b1d Prevention may be partly achieved through early introduction of peanuts to the diets of pregnant women and babies. It is recommended that babies at high risk be given peanut products in areas where medical care is available as early as 4 months of age. Oral immunotherapy results in some degree of tolerance in about 65% of children, though side effects are frequent.
