Chlorodendrales Vesicles budding from the trans-Golgi face carry the scales Chlorodendrales are an order of green, flagellated, thecate eukaryotes, within the green algae class Chlorodendrophyceae. external scales within the Golgi apparatus, and secrete the scales via the endomembrane system. Additionally, they are photoautotrophs, meaning they produce their own food through the conversion of sunlight into chemical energy. Prasinophyceae are defined by their cellular scales which are composed of carbohydrates, and Chlorodendrales are unique within this group due to these scales forming a fused thecal wall. Species within Chlorodendrales live in both marine and fresh water habitats, occupying both benthic and planktonic food webs. Cells of Chlorodendrales are completely covered in scales, which fuse around the cell body producing the theca, but remain individually separated on the flagella, of which there are typically four per cell 93e1636707

Cells of the basal layer are cuboidal (cube-shaped), or columnar (column-shaped), while the cells of the superficial layer vary in appearance depending on the degree of distension. These cells appear to be cuboidal with a domed apex when the organ or the tube in which they reside is not stretched. When the organ or tube is stretched (such as when the bladder is filled with urine), the tissue compresses and the cells become stretched. Transitional epithelium The membrane is made up of a hexagonal lattice put together in the Golgi apparatus and implanted into the surface Transitional epithelium, also known as urothelium is a type of stratified epithelium that changes shape in response to stretching. The bladder, for example, has a need for great distension. membrane synthesized in the Golgi apparatus. Transitional epithelium lines all of the organs of the urinary system – the kidneys, ureters, bladder, and the urethra, hence its alternative name of urothelium. This tissue consists of multiple layers of epithelial cells which can contract and expand in order to adapt to the degree of distension needed. Transitional epithelium usually appears cuboidal when relaxed and squamous when stretched 93e1636707

Golgi apparatus Part of the endomembrane system in the cytoplasm, it packages proteins into membrane-bound vesicles inside the cell before the vesicles are sent to their destination. The Golgi apparatus (/ˈɡɒldʒi/), also known as the Golgi complex, Golgi body, or simply the Golgi, is an organelle found in most eukaryotic cells. It resides at the intersection of the secretory, lysosomal, and endocytic pathways. It is of particular importance in processing proteins for secretion, containing a set of glycosylation enzymes that attach various sugar monomers to proteins as the proteins move through the apparatus 93e1636707

O-linked glycosylation O-glycosylation is a post-translational modification that occurs after the protein has been synthesised. synthesised. O-glycosylation occurs in all domains of life, including eukaryotes, archaea and a number of pathogenic bacteria including *Burkholderia cenocepacia*, *Neisseria gonorrhoeae* and *Acinetobacter baumannii*. In eukaryotes, it occurs in the endoplasmic reticulum, Golgi apparatus and occasionally in the cytoplasm; in prokaryotes, it occurs in the cytoplasm. O-glycans, which are the sugars added to the serine or threonine, have numerous functions throughout the body, including trafficking of cells in the immune system, allowing recognition of foreign material, controlling cell metabolism and providing cartilage and tendon flexibility. Because of the many functions they have, changes in O-glycosylation are important in many diseases including cancer, diabetes and Alzheimer's. In eukaryotes, it occurs in the endoplasmic reticulum, Golgi apparatus and occasionally in the cytoplasm; in prokaryotes, it occurs in the O-linked glycosylation is the attachment of a sugar molecule to the oxygen atom of serine (Ser) or threonine (Thr) residues in a protein.

Several different sugars can be added to the serine or threonine, and they affect the protein in different ways by changing protein stability and regulating protein activity 93e1636707

Brefeldin A [citation needed] Brefeldin A is found naturally as a white to off-white Brefeldin A is a lactone antiviral produced by the fungus *Penicillium brefeldianum*. Brefeldin A inhibits protein transport from the endoplasmic reticulum to the golgi complex indirectly by preventing association of COP-I coat to the Golgi membrane. and vesicle transport dynamics between the endoplasmic reticulum and Golgi apparatus. Brefeldin A was initially isolated with hopes to become an antiviral drug but is now primarily used in research to study protein transport 93e1636707

Wrinkly skin syndrome There are only about 30 known cases of WSS as of 2010. Limited treatment options are available but long-term prognosis is variable from patient to patient, based on individual case studies. Some skin symptoms recede with increasing age, while progressive neurological advancement of the disorder causes seizures and mental deterioration later in life for some patients. The disorder exhibits an autosomal recessive inheritance pattern with mutations in the ATP6V0A2 gene, leading to abnormal glycosylation events. Several drugs including vincristine and colcemid are similar to nocodazole in that they interfere with microtubule polymerization 93e1636707

The compound gets its name from a species of anamorph fungus of the *Penicillium* genus known as

Eupenicillium brefeldianum, though it is found in a variety of species that span several genera. It was first isolated from Penicillium decumbens in 1958 by V.L. Singleton who initially called it Decumbin. It was later identified as a metabolite by H.P. Siggs who then went on to identify the chemical structure of the compound in 1971. Since then several successful total synthesis methods have been described. Interest in researching brefeldin A was initially lacking due to poor antiviral activity. However, upon discovery of its mechanism involving disruption of protein transport by Takatsuki and Tamura in 1985 and the cytotoxic effects observed in certain cancer cell lines, research efforts... 93e1636707

Endomembrane system In eukaryotes the organelles of the endomembrane system include: the nuclear membrane, the endoplasmic reticulum, the Golgi apparatus, lysosomes, vesicles, endosomes, and cell membrane among others. The The endomembrane system is composed of the different membranes (endomembranes) that are suspended in the cytoplasm within a eukaryotic cell. The system is defined more accurately as the set of membranes that forms a single functional and developmental unit, either being connected directly, or exchanging material through vesicle transport. These membranes divide the cell into functional and structural compartments, or organelles. system include: the nuclear membrane, the endoplasmic reticulum, the Golgi apparatus, lysosomes, vesicles, endosomes, and cell membrane among others. Importantly, the endomembrane system does not include the membranes of plastids or mitochondria, but might have evolved partially from the actions of the latter (see below) 93e1636707

Daclatasvir is used only in combination therapy for the treatment of hepatitis C genotype 1, 3, or 4 infections; the... 93e1636707 Common side effects when used with sofosbuvir and daclatasvir include headache, feeling tired, and nausea. With daclatasvir, sofosbuvir, and ribavirin the most common side effects are headache, feeling tired, nausea, and red blood cell breakdown. It should not be used with St. John's wort, rifampin, or carbamazepine.
